2020-2021 Next Generation Scholarship

The Application

The 2020-2021 Next Generation scholarship application consists of two phases. In the first phase, applicants will submit an essay, personal brand video, two letters of recommendation, resume, headshot and school transcripts. Applications are due on **April 10, 2020.**

Applicants will be notified by **May 5, 2020** if they are selected to move on to the semi-finalist stage. In this phase, 25 students will be required to complete a case study created in collaboration with **PetSmart, Inc.** and two interviews with assigned retailers by **August 7, 2020**. From there, 10 students will advance and complete quick-fire video interviews with the NRF team. The top five finalists will then be selected and notified by **September 16, 2020**. The finalists will complete final round interviews with members of the NRF Foundation Board of Directors to determine the top recipient.

The top recipient will receive a \$25,000 tuition scholarship, and four finalists will receive \$10,000 tuition scholarships.

Eligibility

The NRF Foundation Next Generation Scholarship is open to junior and senior students enrolled full-time at a NRF University Member school when the scholarship is awarded in January 2021.

Requirements:

- Juniors or seniors enrolled full time at a University Member school at the time when the scholarship is presented in <u>January 2021</u> (Note: current sophomores can apply if they will be of junior standing in January of 2021)
- Must not have previously received an award of \$10,000 or more from the NRF Foundation

- Must be U.S. citizens or legal U.S. residents eligible to work in the United States
- Must have a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale
- Must have prior or current experience working in a retail job or internship. This could be anything from working as a bagger at a grocery store or a server/host at a restaurant to having a summer internship with a retailer.
- Students in any major are eligible. Possible majors include business, merchandising, supply chain, analytics, entrepreneurship, finance, accounting, retail studies, computer science, marketing, communications, etc.

The 2020 CM CARES Religious Scholarship Program

For the fourth year in a row, CM CARES will award up to \$250,000 in scholarships to deserving graduate-level religious scholars.  - **Applicants must be pursuing a master's or doctorate degree in an area of religious study. This can be any area of religious study provided the applicant intends to enter full-time ministry following completion of studies.
 - ***Institutions in the process of achieving accreditation.
- Demonstrate personal impact throughout education, work experiences, and volunteerism.
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or its equivalent.

- Be committed to entering the practice of full-time ministry* in the United States**
 following completion of studies.
 - *Full-time ministry includes holding a paid leadership position within a church body as a primary means of income.
 - **Must be physically within the United States.
- International applicants are not eligible to apply for this program. Each scholarship is a one-time, non-renewable award. Previous winners are not eligible.

The American Philosophical Society Library & Museum in Philadelphia invites applications for short-term residential research fellowships. These funding opportunities provide 1- to 3- months of support for researchers in residence and are open to scholars in **all fields** who show a demonstrated need to use the Library & Museum's collections for their project. Approximately 25-30 short-term fellowships are awarded each year.

The APS Library & Museum's collections make it among the premier institutions for documenting and exhibiting the history of the American Revolution and founding, the history of science from Newton to NASA, Native American languages and culture, and the development of American anthropology. The Library & Museum houses over 13 million manuscripts; 350,000 volumes of printed materials and bound periodicals; 250,000 images, fine art, and other objects; thousands of maps and prints; and more than 3,500 hours of audio recordings of Native American languages.

A stipend of \$3,000 per month is awarded for a minimum of one month and a maximum of three months. The stipend is paid after the awardee arrives at the APS Library & Museum to begin their fellowship. The duration of award is requested by the candidate, but the final decision is made by the Fellowship Committee. The purpose of the stipend is to defray the costs of working in Philadelphia.

Fellowships may be taken starting any day no earlier than June 1, 2020 and must be completed by May 31, 2021. Fellows are required to be in residence for four to twelve consecutive weeks, depending upon the length of the award. Fellows do not have to decide on the dates of their fellowship right away; they have one year to decide, although most take their fellowships during the summer period.
