PROGRAM OVFRVIEW

This nationally recognized program provides a comprehensive, streamlined, and timely review of pediatrics for physicians who are preparing for the American Board of Pediatrics certification examination and re-certification process. It is the only completely comprehensive pediatric board review available and is scheduled shortly before the examination to maintain maximum familiarity with test-taking skills and enable maximum retention of material.

The complete review is a six-day course in order to cover all the relevant material.
