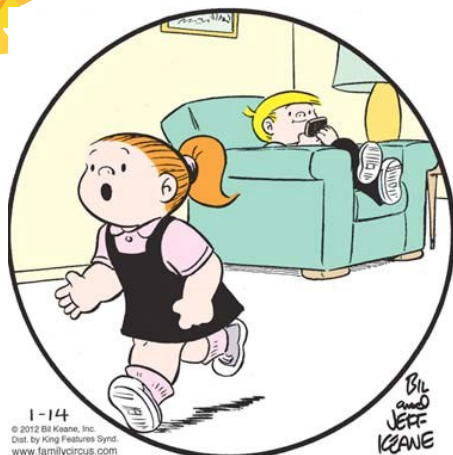

Let's send our parish kids into the new school year assured of God's promises and our loving support. Be sure to join us and to include all of our young people in your prayers as they go back to school.

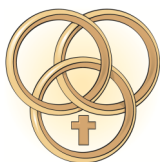
