Each section begins with a captivating nature story that introduces the character quality being taught, and continues with interesting facts on the selected animal's qualities and physical features. This four-book series is designed for children nine to twelve years old. Each book has thirteen lessons and are recommended for one-on-one, small group, or classroom study. Among its strengths are the many activities designed to help the child understand and apply the truths personally. There are no student workbooks necessary, and each book has handouts designed for the leader to photocopy for the students.

Book 1, *Beginning the Christian Adventure*. Designed to introduce children to the thrill of walking with Jesus day by day.

Book 2, *Discovering Our Awesome God*. Introduces students to the wonders and awesome nature of God—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—and how to talk to our loving God.

Book 3, *Growing in God's Word*. Gives student a foundation in how the Bible is arranged and how the Old Testament is God's plan for humanity. This book also uses practical applications for using God's Word daily.

Partners in Discipleship, by Jan VanDyke, published by Camp Beechpoint, Allegan, MI. This is a unique program in which its impact is attributed to its foundational emphasis on one-on-one discipleship. Even when used in the church setting the program, requires a period of time given over to the leader spending quality one-on-one time with the child, helping him grow spiritually. The one-on-one time is not only for instruction and encouragement but also emphasizes accountability.
