- New Students:** all new students are strongly encouraged to complete the registration process as early as possible, preferably prior to end of Summer for fall entering students. The registration process for new students includes placement testing, college orientation, financial aid processing, career advising and academic program selection, and initial course selection. - Financial aid:** students are strongly urged to apply for financial aid (www.fafsa.gov) as early as possible (preferably by March 1st) for the academic year beginning in the fall. Please contact the financial aid office for details.

General registration ends February 1 for Credit students only. Registration remains open until February 9 for 12 Week Session students, and until March 9 for 8 Week Session for adult education and short-term students.

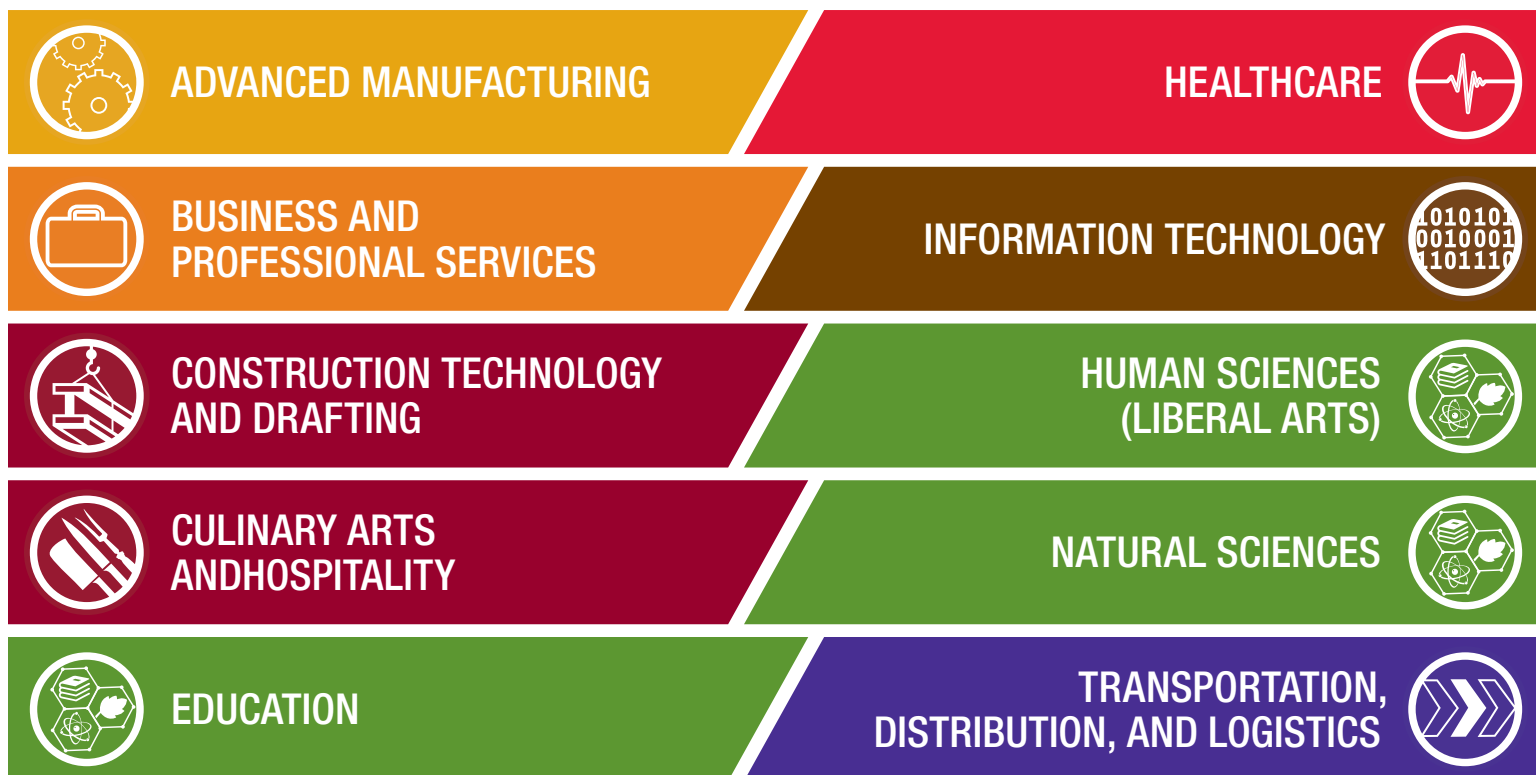

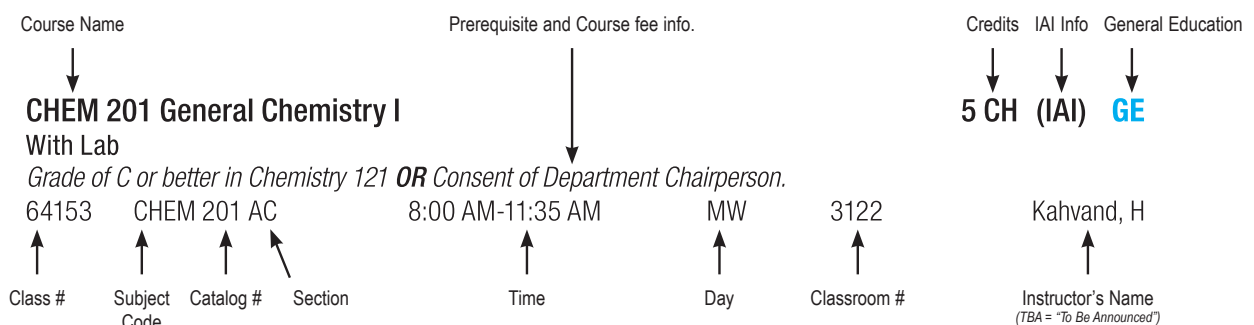
