Mr. Dailey has produced three recordings: “Come and Rejoice” (Cantate), “Sing!” (Boston Children’s Chorus) and “Voices for Voices” (Jacksonville Children’s Chorus). His work can also be heard on “A Boston Christmas” (Back Bay Chorale), “Building Bridges” (Mystic Chorale), and “Amani Celebration,” a limited-edition compact disc of holiday songs from 15 children’s choirs to benefit African children who have been orphaned because of the HIV/AIDS epidemic.

Mr. Dailey received a Bachelor of Music Education degree with a concentration in Voice from Westminster Choir College and a Master of Music Education in Choral Conducting from Appalachian State University’s Hayes School of Music. Mr. Dailey is also trained in Kindermusik.

Darren Dailey is celebrating his eighth season in Jacksonville, where he has been shaping The Jacksonville Children’s Chorus into a world-class organization. Under his artistic leadership the Chorus has grown to serve over 450 First Coast children annually with five core performance choirs, multiple satellite rehearsal locations, and outreach throughout the region. He has introduced Chorus singers and their audiences to innovative and renowned guest artists, and he has broadened the Chorus’s opportunities including performance tours in the Southeastern states, to Carnegie Hall and Lincoln Center and Ireland.

A nationally recognized clinician and conductor, Mr. Dailey has served as guest conductor in Avery Fisher Hall at Lincoln Center and at the ACDA Honor Choir in Seattle. He has presented workshops for the National Association of Pastoral Musicians, Organization of Kodály Educators, American Choral Directors Association, Music Educator’s National Conference, and many universities. As the founding artistic director of the Boston Children’s Chorus, Mr. Dailey and his chorus performed at the 2004 Democratic Convention, appeared as the host chorus on the television special, “Raising the Roof: A Celebration of the Life of Martin Luther King, Jr. in Song,” broadcast nationally on WGN, and performed internationally in Japan.

Ms. Holland attended Pfeiffer College and received her master's degree from Indiana University. While at Indiana University she was an associate conductor of the University Children's Choir under the direction of Dr. Mary Goetze. She received her Off-Schulwerk certifications from the University of Memphis and has received the Artist Teacher Diploma from the Choral Music Experience Institute with renowned conductor/teacher Doreen Rao.

Ms. Holland is a member of Chorus America and the American Choral Director's Association, having served as the State and Divisional Repertoire & Standards Committee Chair for Children's Choirs, was the 2008 Children's Honor's Choir Chairperson, served on the planning team for the 2012 Southern Division Convention and is currently the President for the North Carolina American Choral Directors Association.

Sandy R. Holland, is currently in her 23rd year as the Artistic Director of the Charlotte Children's Choir. Ensembles under Ms. Holland's direction appear regularly with professional organizations such as the Charlotte Symphony, and Opera Carolina and have been selected to sing at state, local and national music educator's conferences. (ACDA, NCMEA, OAKE, AOSA). The Choir has also toured extensively in the United States as well as abroad, performing in such venues as Carnegie Hall, Notre Dame Cathedral (Paris), St. Peter's Basilica (Rome), National Cathedral (DC) was invited to perform at the White House (2012) and recently completed a successful tour to Costa Rica.

In 2008, Ms. Holland was selected as a Chorus America Masterclass Conducting Fellow with Dr. Joseph Flummerfelt and Dr. Ann Howard Jones held in San Francisco, CA. Sandy is the founding director of the "A Children's Celebration in Song" summer program serving 150 children in the greater Charlotte area, and co-founder of the Annual Piedmont Invitational Children's Choir Festival for children's choirs across the state of North Carolina. An experienced and sought after choral clinician for children, junior high and high school women's choirs, Sandy has conducted All State choruses, workshops and clinics in 14 states.
