# STAAR

- State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness
- First administered in Spring of 2012
- Reading in grades 3-English II (10<sup>th</sup>)
- Math in grades 3-Algebra I (8<sup>th</sup>/9<sup>th</sup>)
- Writing in grades 4 & 7
- Science in grades 5, 8, & Biology (9<sup>th</sup>)
- Social studies in grades 8 and U.S. History (11<sup>th</sup>)
- Passing standard remained constant from 2012-2015; increased in 2016

# CHANGES TO STAAR IN 2017

- Only one form of test—paper or online (no more STAAR A or STAAR L)
- Enhanced online supports
- New labels for performance standards
- CSR (Confidential Student Report) now SRC (STAAR Report Card) available online at [www.texasassessment.com](http://www.texasassessment.com) as of June 30 for grades 3-8 (already available for STAAR EOC exams)

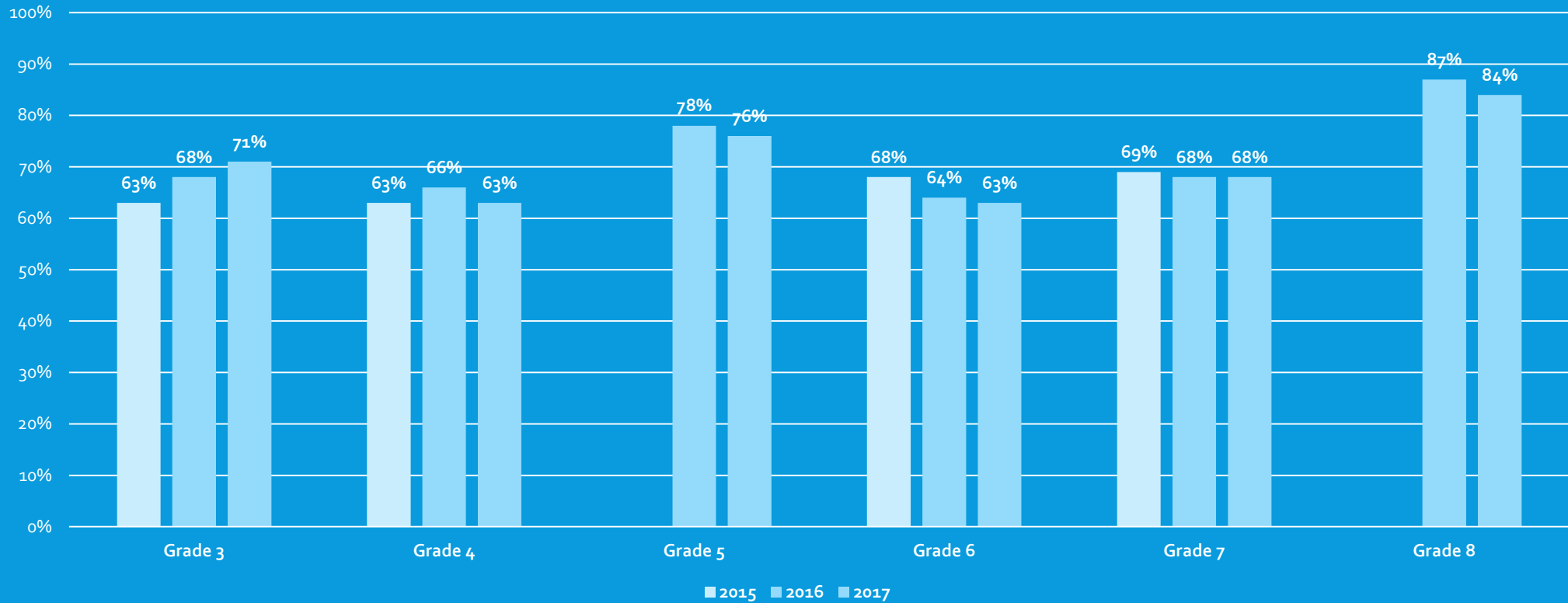
# LABELS FOR STAAR PERFORMANCE 2017

| Phase-in Level<br>II: Satisfactory        | Approaches<br>Grade Level   |    | <u>Passed</u><br><b>Some knowledge of course content but may be missing critical elements, student needs additional support</b> |
| Final Level II:<br>Postsecondary<br>Ready | Meets Grade<br>Level        |   | <u>Passed</u><br>Strong knowledge of course content, student is prepared to progress to next grade.                             |
| Advanced                                  | Masters Grade<br>Level      |  | <u>Passed</u><br>Mastery of the course knowledge and skills is shown, student is on track for college and/or career.            |

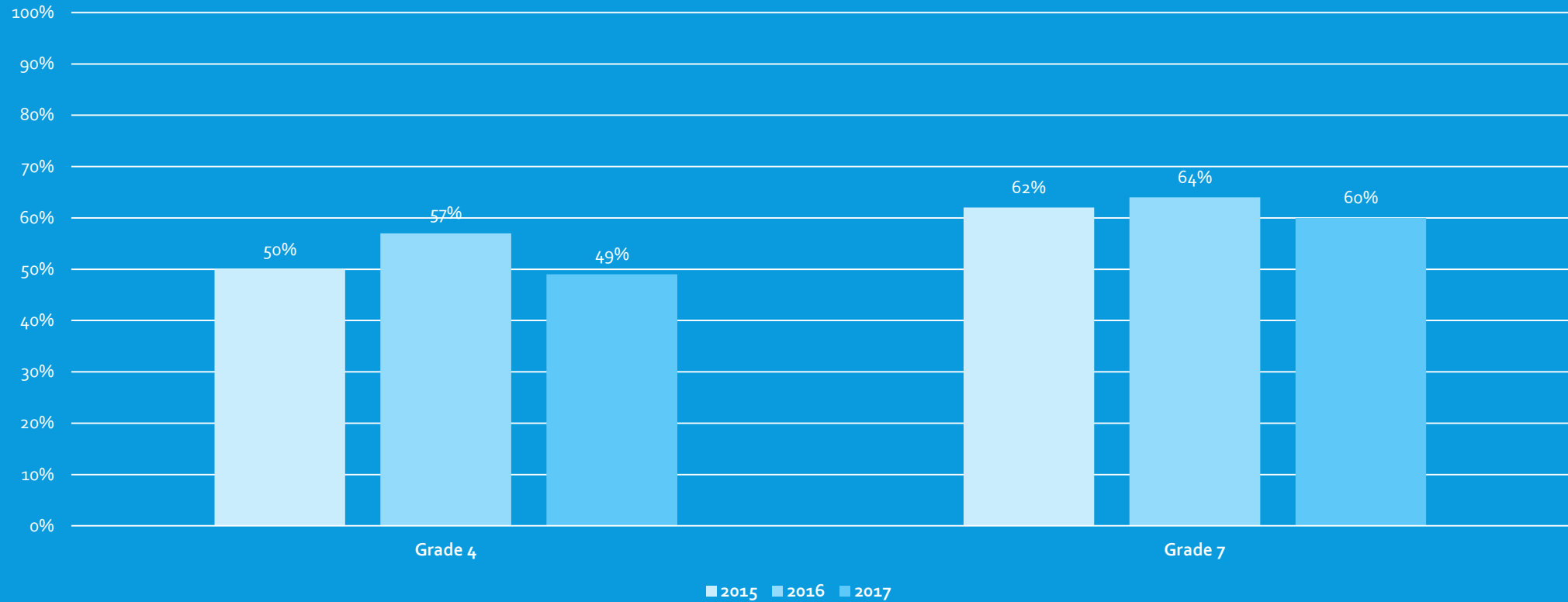
## Hays CISD STAAR Reading Scores

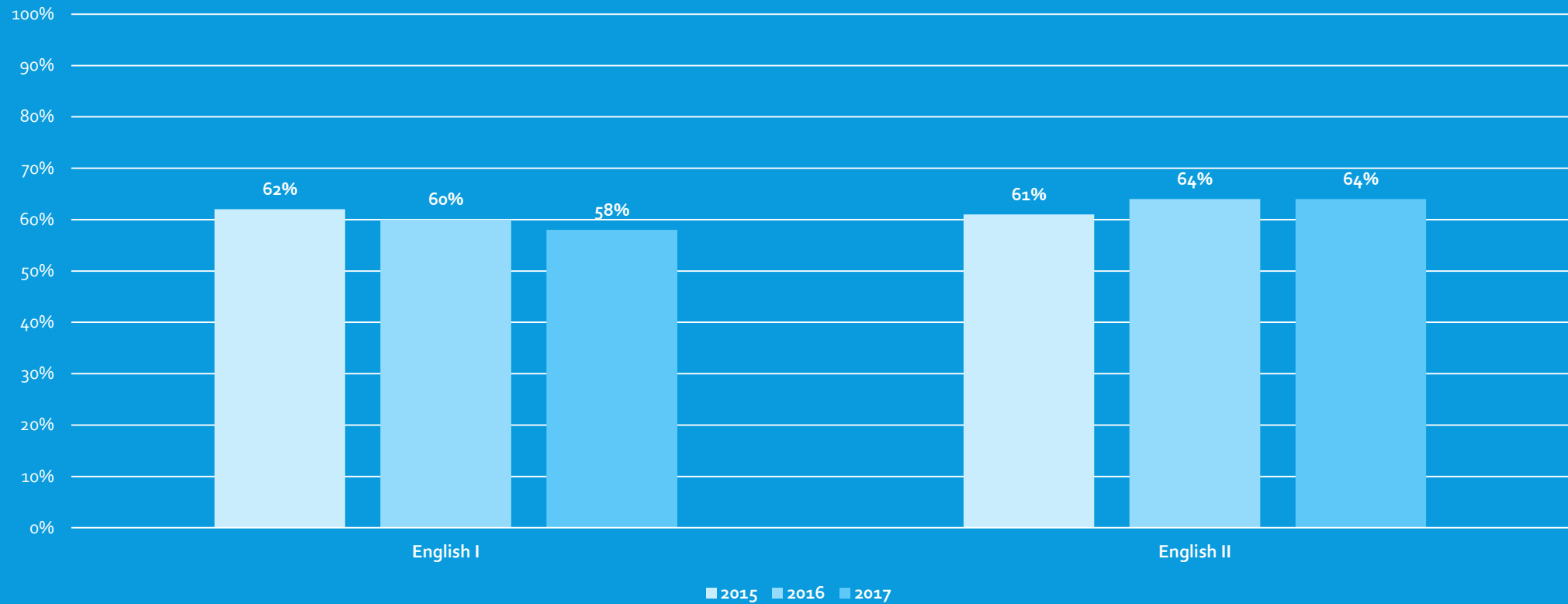
## Hays CISD STAAR Writing Scores

## Hays CISD STAAR ELA Scores

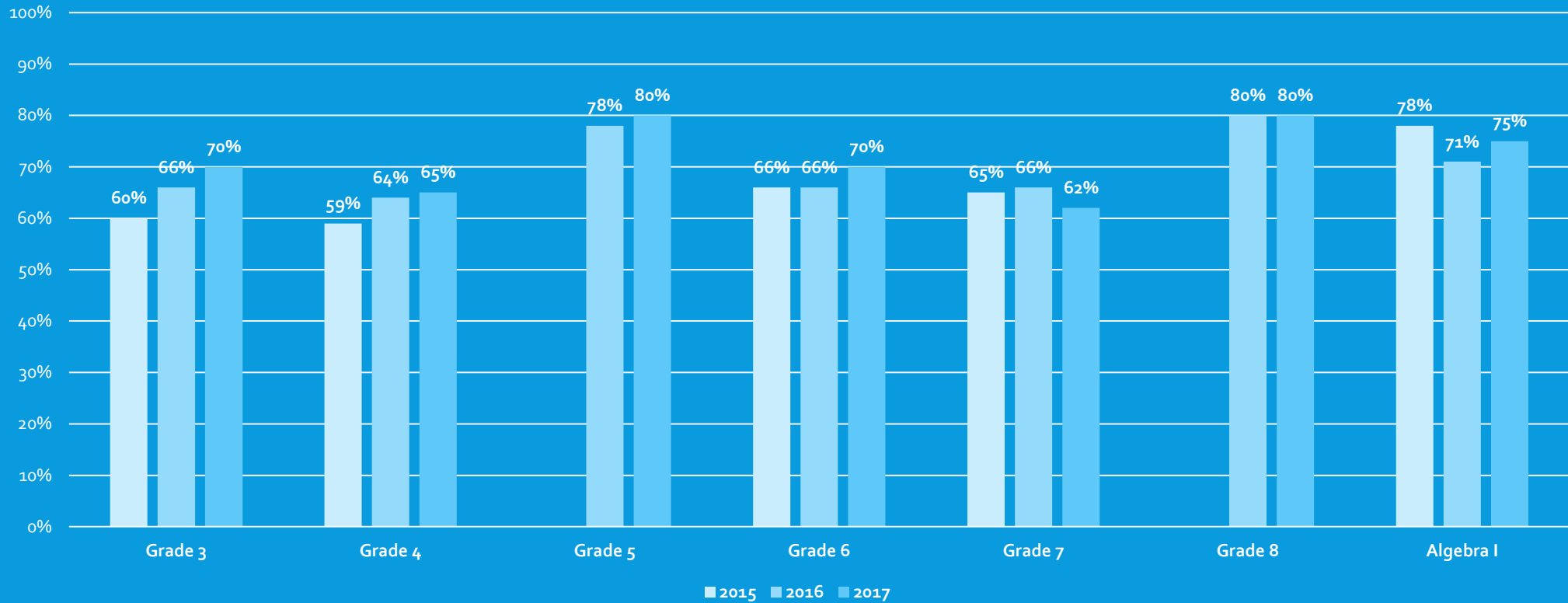

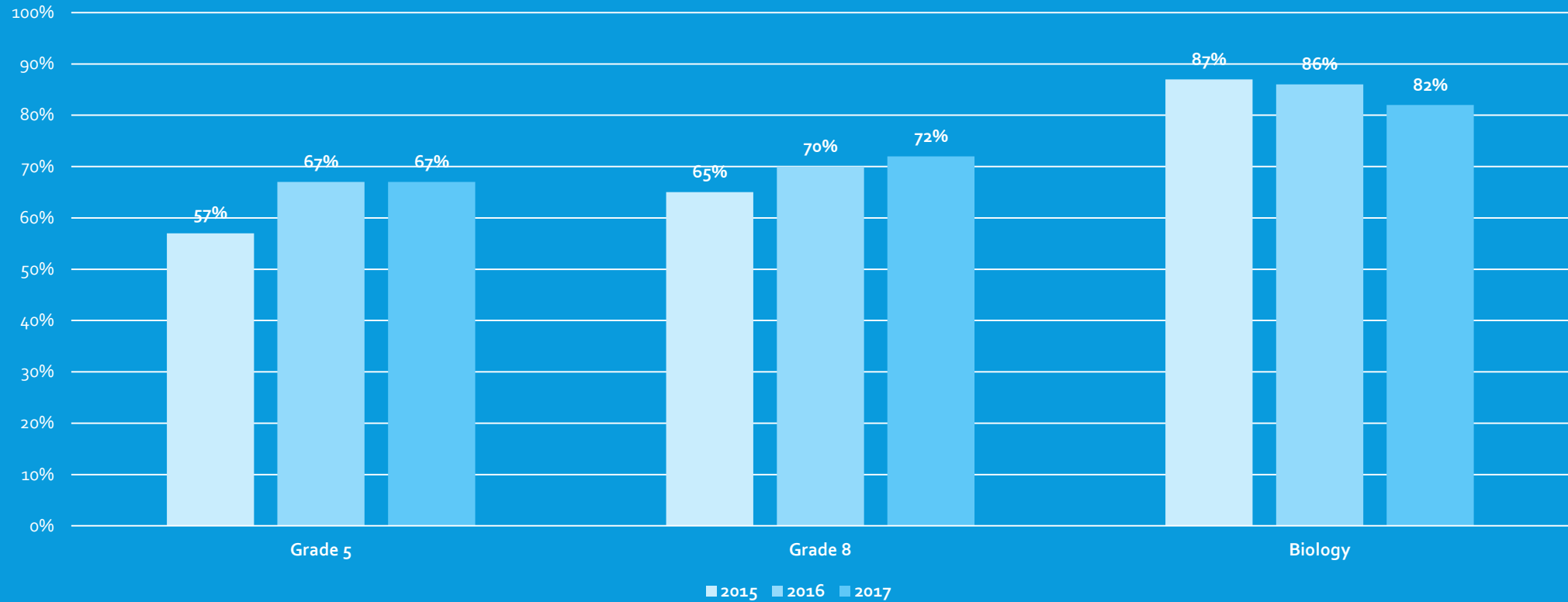
### Hays CISD STAAR Math Scores

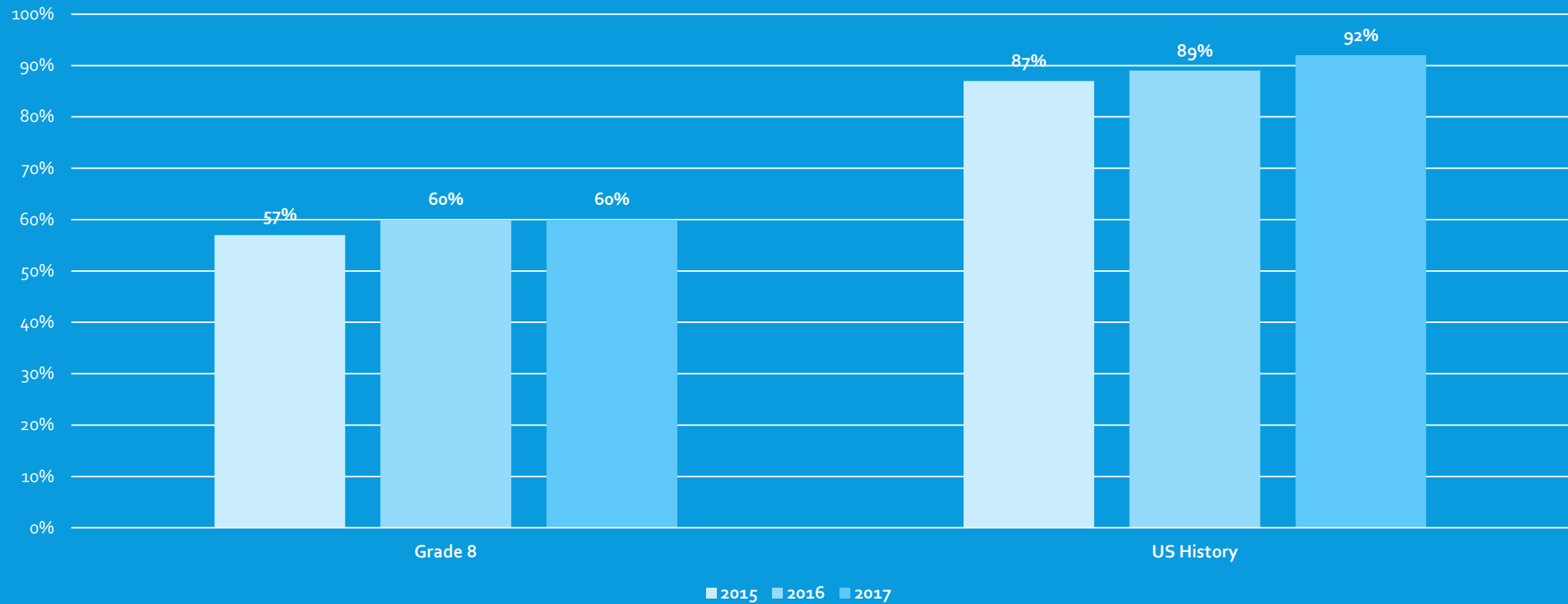
### Hays CISD STAAR Science Scores
