Cutting Directions

Background fabric

- Cut 1 square 10.5" x 10.5"

Butterfly wing fabric

- Cut 1 of each wing

Butterfly body

- Cut 1 body

Tulip fabric

- Cut 3 tulips

Stem fabric

- Cut 3 Stems

Long leaf fabric

- Cut 2 left leaves
- Cut 2 right leaves

Short leaf fabric

- Cut 1 left leaf
- Cut 1 right leaf




Directions

1) Position the tulips on the 10.5" x 10.5" background square


Measures 10.5" x 10.5"

2) Position the butterfly wings and body on the 10.5" x 10.5" background square Measures 10.5" x 10.5" Make 1 unit

3) Applique the flowers and Butterfly. I use a blanket stitch


Half Square Triangles Tutorial


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST





-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
