


# LIVING AND NONLIVING THINGS

### How do animals move?

Animals use their body parts to move around.

#### Why do animals move?

- Animals move around to get food to eat. They need food to live.
- Animals move to get the water they need to live.
- Animals can move away from other animals that might hurt them. This keeps them safe.
- Animals move to find a place to stay safe when the weather is bad.





#### What do plants need to live?

- Plants need water.
- Diants nood sunlight



### What do animals need to live?

- Animals need to eat **food**.
- Animals need water to drink.
- Animals need their own space to live in.
- Animals need a place to live that will keep them safe. This place is called a **shelter**.






An animal is a consumer. A consumer is a living thing that eats other living things in order to live.
