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#### GRADUATE READING LIST

What follows is a minimum list of readings with which advanced students of theatre should be familiar. It ranges from plays and books about historical backgrounds, theory and criticism, and aesthetics, to the creative and technical work of actors, directors, designers, technicians, and managers.

The list is divided into Required and Recommended readings:

MFA students are responsible for the <u>Required</u> readings in Dramatic Literature (i.e., plays), Dramatic Theory and Criticism, and Historical Backgrounds, plus any other readings their major adviser or committee may prescribe.

In addition:

MFA students are responsible for <u>Required</u> readings pertaining to their specific emphasis.

Knowledge of many of these readings will be acquired through regular course work in theatre. However students will need to take the initiative and explore also the <u>Recommended</u> works to provide as much groundwork as possible for their degree examinations and for developing their own artistic point-of-view.
