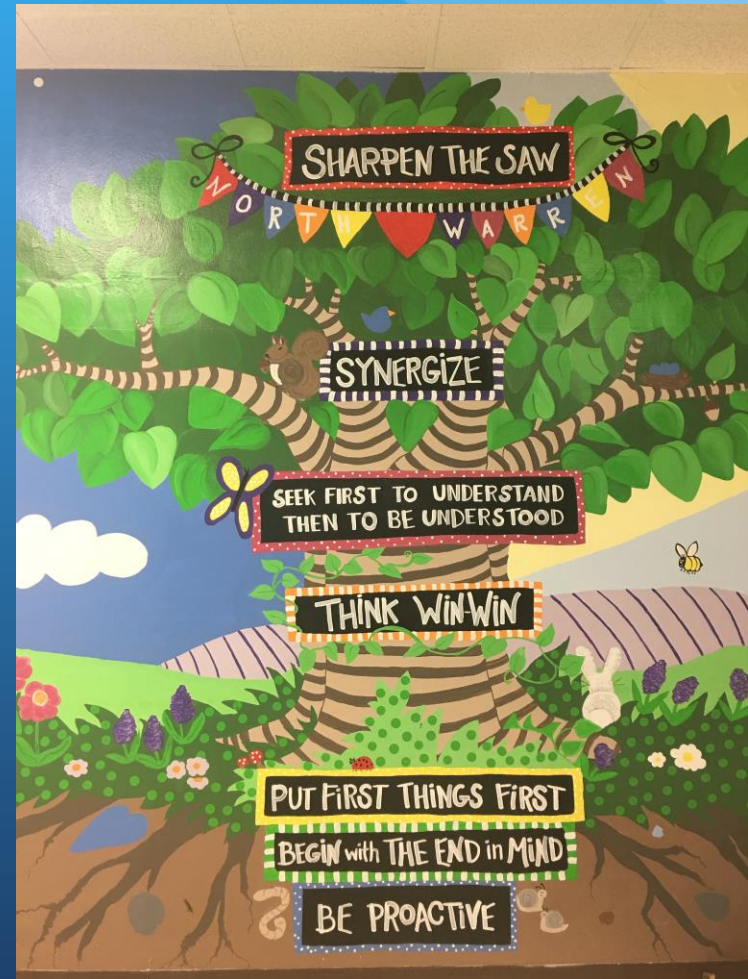
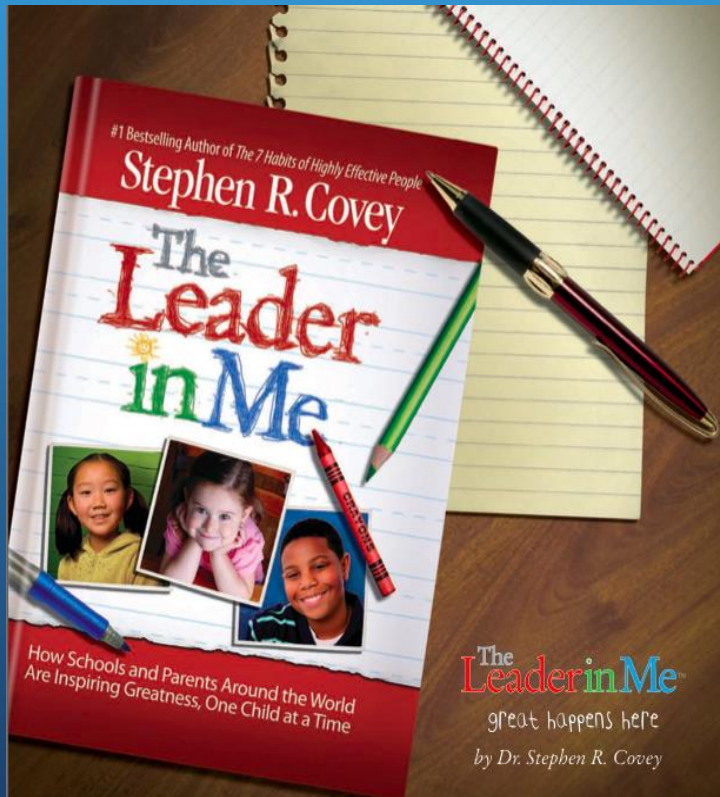

Mission: To learn as much as we can to be the best that we can

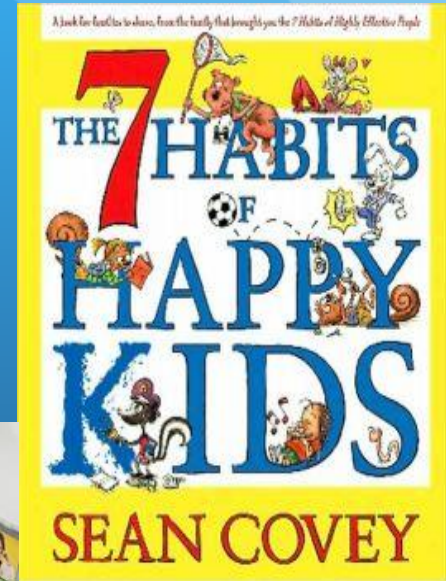
- Share the mission and vision with all stakeholders

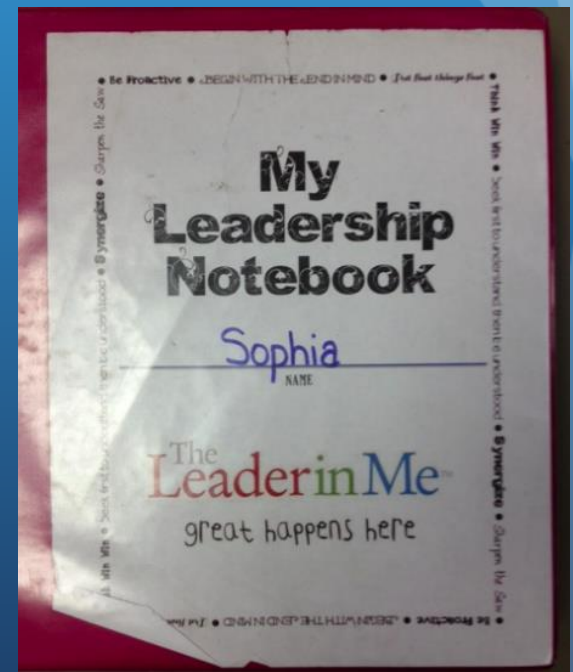




# *Put First Things First*

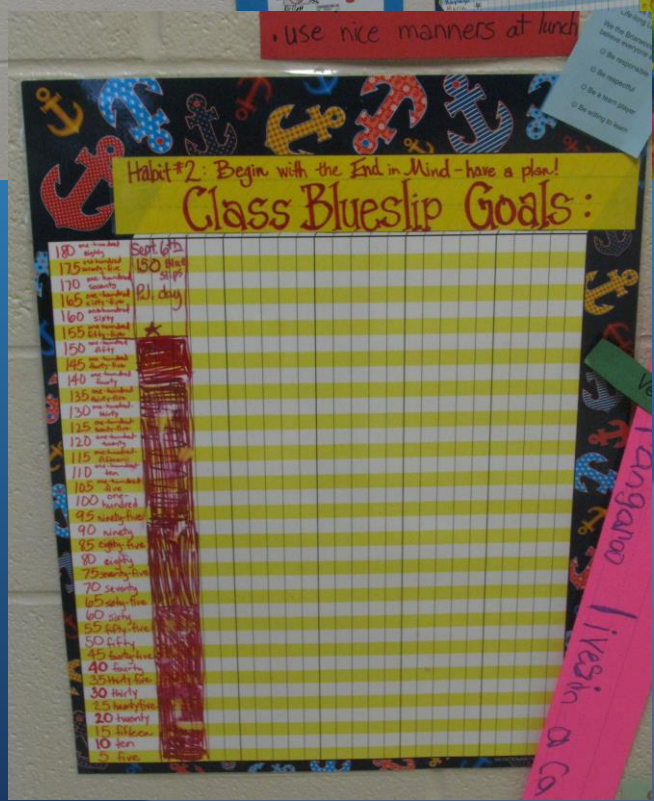

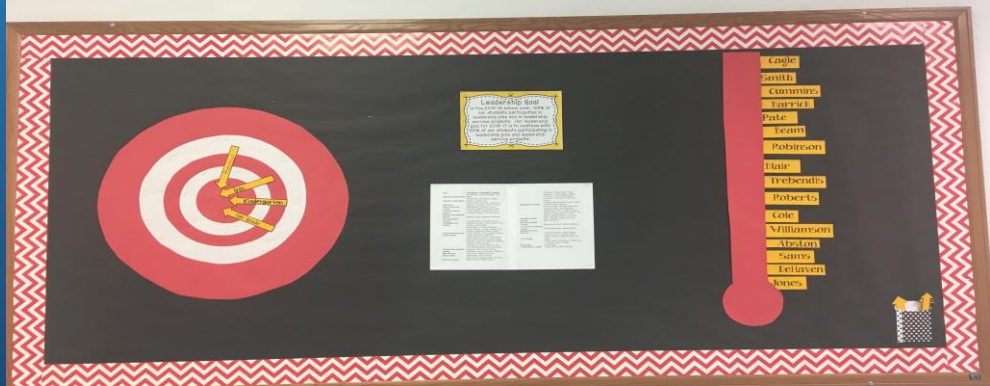
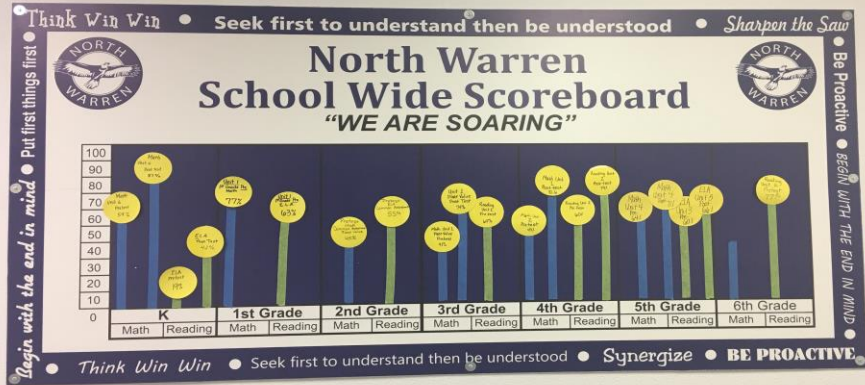


# Scoreboards

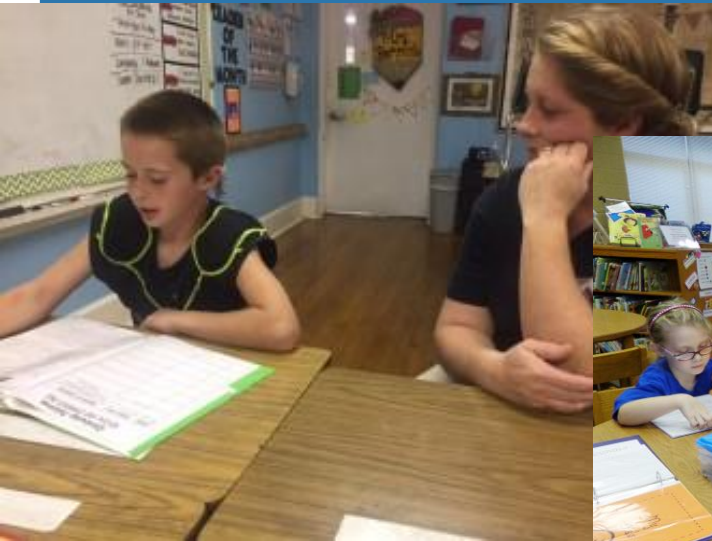

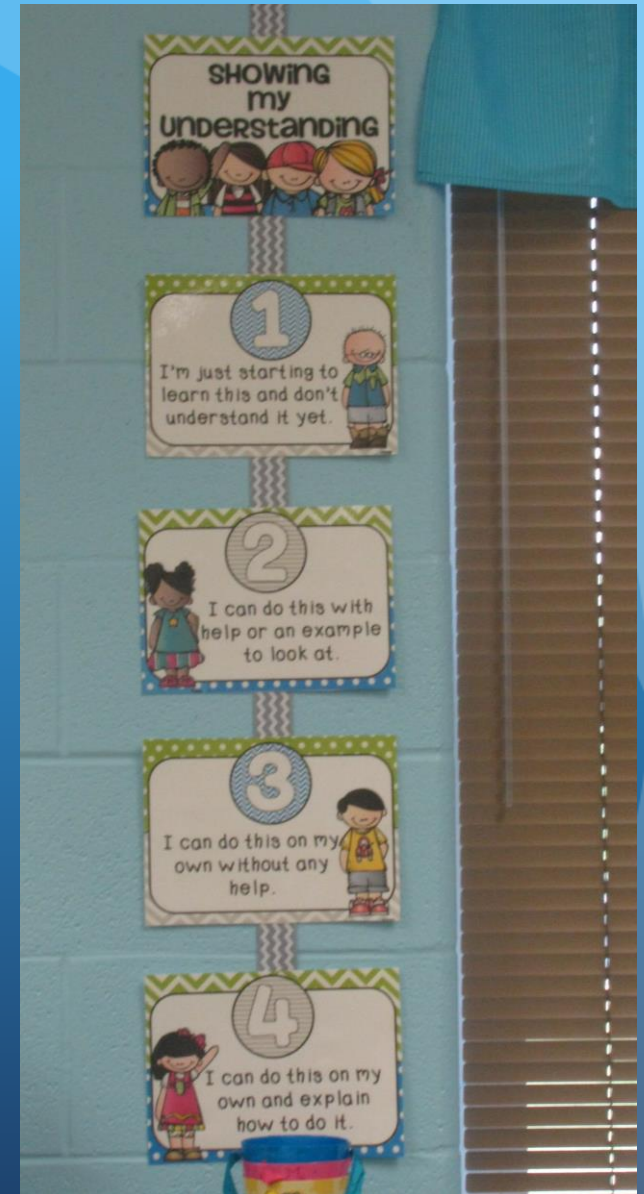
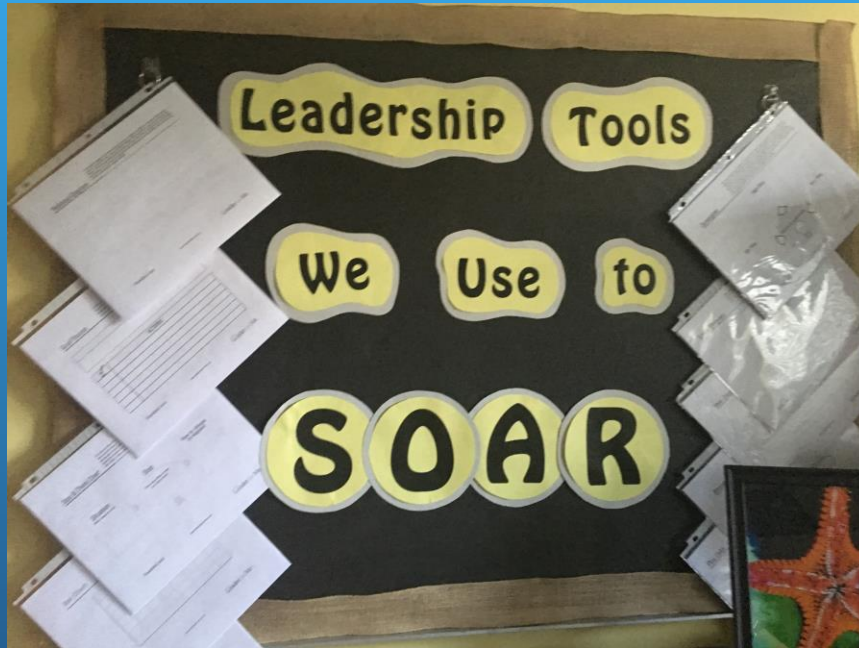
# Student-led Conferences

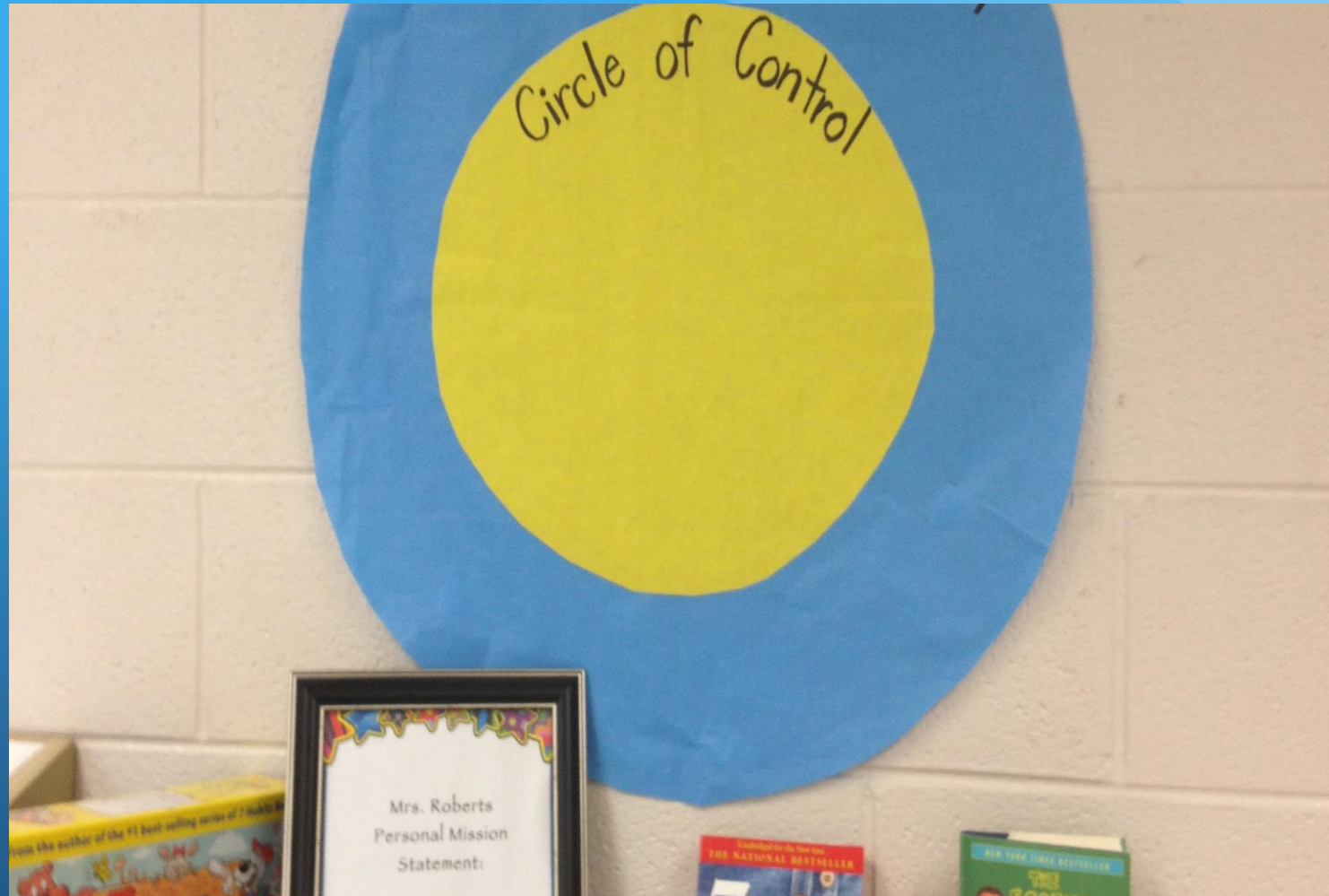
- Have the students lead the Parent/Teacher Conferences by sharing their Leadership Notebooks, goals, and progress monitoring
- Promote positive relationships and discussions during the conferences





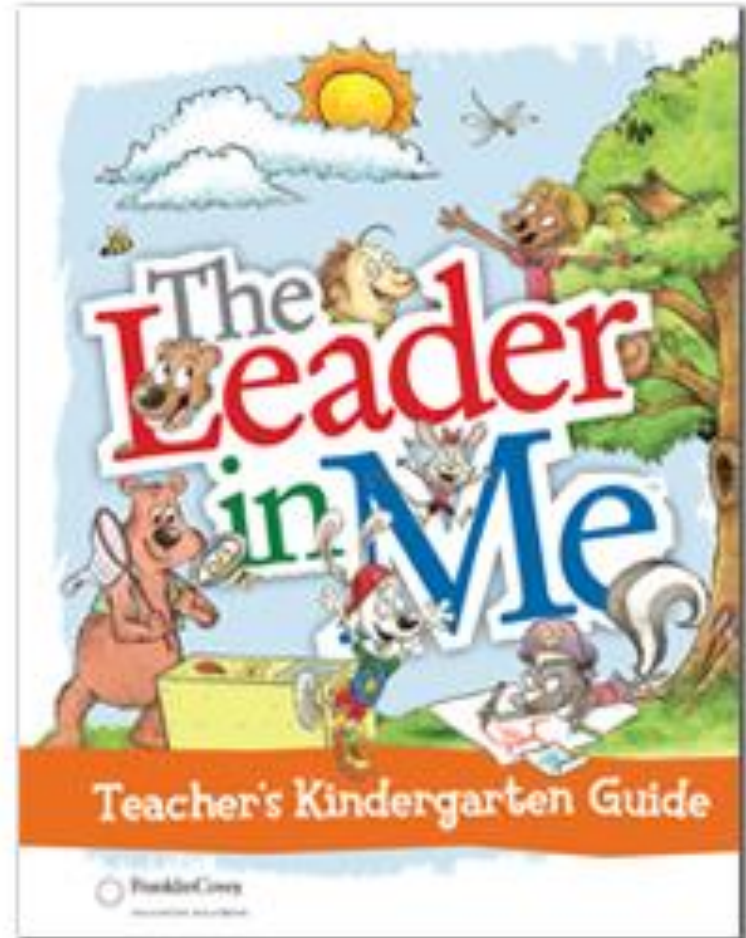

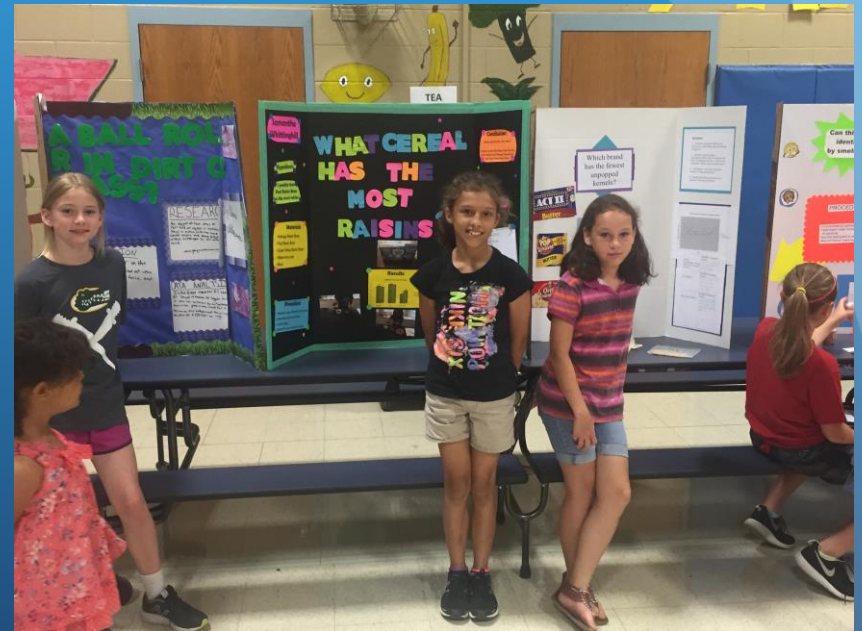
