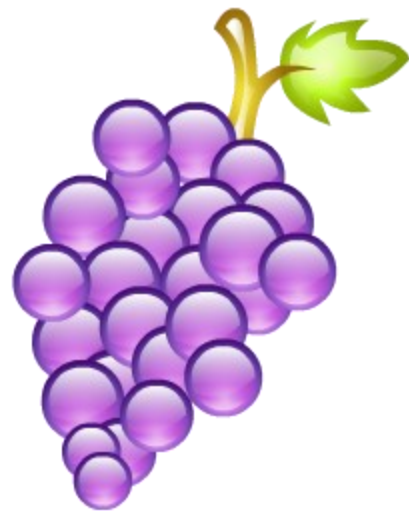

Preventing Identity Theft *

Identity theft is the deliberate use of someone else's identity, usually as a method to gain a financial advantage or obtain credit and other benefits in the other person's name, and perhaps to the other person's disadvantage or loss.

Did you get a notice that says a company lost your personal information in a data breach? Did you lose your wallet? Or learn that an online account was hacked? Learn steps you can take to help protect yourself from identity theft.

McCord Library now has hotspots for McCord patrons to use.

What is a hotspot?

A hotspot is a device that allows a user to have wireless Internet on their phone, tablet, or computer even if they don't have Internet access at home. Simply connect to the hotspot using the WiFi menu on your device.

- Hotspots check out for 10 days
- Hotspots may only be checked out by adults
- Hotspots are only available to McCord patrons
- Fines for overdue hotspots are \$1 per day

What can I do with hotspot Internet?

You can browse the Internet. This means you can look up information on google, use our website, check your Facebook, read the news, etc. Though you can look at videos on YouTube, we don't recommend it because the data provided by these hotspots is not unlimited. After a few videos, your internet may run out.

What happens if I am late returning the hotspot?

In addition to the fine, the hotspot will be deactivated remotely after a few days.
