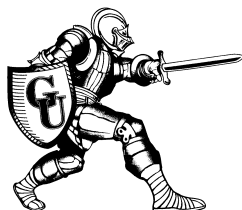

MEET PREVIEW

The Ferris State University Athletics Department will host the 2006 Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Men's and Women's Outdoor Track and Field Championships Thursday and Friday, May 4-5, at FSU's Top Taggart Field in Big Rapids, Mich.

The 34th annual men's event and the 26th annual women's outdoor championships will feature 10 conference schools, including the Ferris State men's and women's track squads. The event will kick off Thursday (May 4) at 3 p.m. (EDT). First day action concludes with the men's 10,000-meter race at approximately 7:55 p.m. (EDT). Final day action Friday (May 5) begins at 11 a.m. (EDT) with the awards ceremony rounding up the event at 3:45 p.m. (EDT).

Admission to the event is \$5 for adults with student tickets \$3 on a one-day basis. Two-day passes will also be offered for \$8 (adults) and \$5 (students) apiece. Parking will be available near the stadium and concessions will be sold throughout the event.

One of the premier NCAA Division II conferences in the nation, the GLIAC holds championships in 21 sports throughout the year. Conference members slated to compete on Friday include Ferris State, Northwood, Grand Valley State, Saginaw Valley State, Michigan Tech, Lake Superior State, Ashland, Findlay and Hillsdale. Northern Michigan will field a women's team only.

Eight places will be awarded for all individual and team relay events with the points figuring into the respective team scores. The closing awards ceremony will include the presentation of the league championship trophy along with season-ending awards for the league's top performers and coaches.

Last season (2005), Grand Valley State captured both the men's and women's outdoor titles on their home track at Lubbers Stadium in Allendale, Mich. GVSU also claimed both the 2006 men's and women's indoor titles in late February (Feb. 24-25) at the Malcolm Athletics Center in Findlay, Ohio. The Lakers have presently won six-straight women's outdoor championships along with three consecutive men's outdoor crowns heading into this year's event.

Overall, Hillsdale leads the GLIAC with nine outdoor championships in the women's division. The Chargers have also earned runner-up honors nine times since joining the league in 1974. Saginaw Valley State is second with eight championship trophies. Grand Valley State has won six titles and Ashland has emerged victorious twice.

In the men's division, Saginaw Valley State has placed first on seven different occasions in the outdoor meet. Ferris State and Ashland are tied for second with six titles, Hillsdale has won five crowns and GVSU four to date. Wayne State picked up three outdoor titles as a former conference track competitor while Northwood has finished first twice.

Ferris State last hosted the league outdoor meet in 2001 (May 4) at Top Taggart Field when Grand Valley State took both the men's and women's overall championships with 228.50 and 221 points, respectively. This year will mark only the third time the Bulldogs have played host to the event in the last 20 years as the event had not been held in Big Rapids since May 1, 1987, prior to the 2001 meet.

Top Taggart Field serves as the site for the Bulldogs' home track and field meets. The stadium, which also serves as home to FSU's varsity football program, was dedicated October 1957 in honor of the school's first official varsity football coach and his contributions to the institution.

The facility underwent a multi-million dollar renovation in the spring of 1998, which involved the installation of a 400-meter, eight-lane track with a brick red urethane surface surrounding a top-of-the-line artificial turf playing surface. Also, renovations were completed at that time for two shot put circles, two long and triple jump pits, and a pair of pole vault boxes. The facility also includes the three-story Wheeler Pavilion, which was added in 2001 and features a ticket office, club level along with media/game operations area.

In addition to Top Taggart Field, throwing events will also be held just south of the stadium on university practice fields.

The GLIAC Championships will represent the second Ferris home meet of the 2006 campaign as FSU also hosted the annual non-scoring Bulldog Invitational April 8 at Top Taggart Field. Both the Ferris men's and women's teams placed sixth at last year's conference outdoor meet in Allendale.

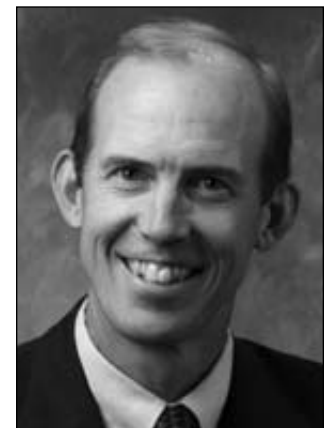

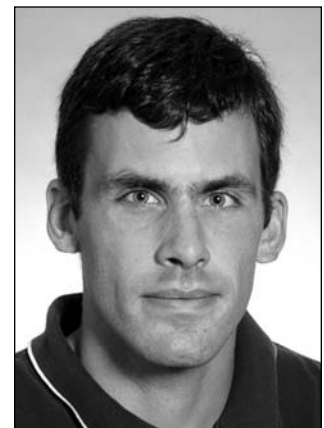

With Ferris State University continually expanding its efforts to accommodate all of its student-athletes, the Bulldog men's and women's cross country and track programs are just two to have become beneficiaries of this progression.

The athletic facilities at Ferris State have undergone a recent transformation in order to provide the varsity athletic programs with first-class facilities for its respective student-athletes.

Katke Golf Course, a university-owned 18-hole golf course situated on the western flank of the Ferris campus, serves as the site of home cross country meets. Katke is named after Mr. and Mrs. Marvin L. Katke, whose generous donation influenced campus development and the initial phase of the golf course. Katke, a friend of Ferris and a Mecosta County native, was vice president for manufacturing of the Ford Motor Company and a 1967 recipient of an honorary degree from FSU. The Katke Golf Course opened in 1974. A new clubhouse was added during the summer of 1999.

The site for the Bulldogs' home track and field meets is Top Taggart Field, named in honor of W.C. "Top" Taggart. The stadium, which also serves as home to FSU's varsity football program, was dedicated October 1957 in honor of the school's first official varsity football coach and his contributions to the institution.

The facility underwent a multi-million dollar renovation in the spring of 1998, which involved the installation of a 400-meter, eight-lane track with a brick red urethane surface surrounding a top-of-the-line artificial turf playing surface. Also, renovations were completed for two shot put circles, two long and triple jump pits, and a pair of pole vault boxes.

Funded by a generous donation from alumni John Wheeler, the new state-of-the-art \$1.8 million Wheeler Pavilion is a three-story building that includes new restroom and concession facilities at the stadium. Construction was completed in August 2001.

The Ferris State Track and Cross Country offices are housed in Ewigleben Sports Arena on the southern edge of campus. The arena includes athletic training and weight room facilities as well as the offices of the athletic department staff. The arena welcomed the addition of the new Jim Wink Arena in the fall of 1999.

The many new facilities, supplemented with existing ones like Ferris State's Racquet and Fitness Center, allow athletes to train and enhance their performance capabilities in the best possible facilities.

WHEELER PAVILION

The \$1.8 million state-of-the-art Wheeler Pavilion is the latest addition to Top Taggart Field and allows Ferris State University to have one of the top NCAA Division II facilities in the nation.

The three-story building was constructed through the generosity of alumnus John Wheeler ('76), Chief Executive Officer of Rockford Construction Company and the Rockford Development Group. Wheeler and his wife, Chris, pledged \$500,000 and an in-kind gift of \$100,000 in professional services.

A public fundraising campaign raised \$600,000 in contributions and pledges, which was matched by the University.

Founded in 1972, the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) continues to be a leader in the development and promotion of intercollegiate athletics for men and women.

During the two years previous to the league's founding, several attempts were made to create a new NCAA College Division conference. In 1971, the Great Lakes Athletic Conference was formed, but plans for the new conference were put on hold and several participating schools subsequently withdrew their support. However, the idea for a new conference didn't die and eventually the GLIAC was formed.

The charter members of the conference were Grand Valley State University, Lake Superior State University, Northwood University and Saginaw Valley State University.

Ferris State University followed soon afterward when they joined the conference along with Oakland University in 1972. The conference continued to expand until it reached its current number of 13 member institutions. The GLIAC's current members are—Ashland University, Ferris State University, The University of Findlay, Gannon University, Grand Valley State University, Hillsdale College, Lake Superior State University, Mercyhurst College, Michigan Technological University, Northern Michigan University, Northwood University, Saginaw Valley State University and Wayne State University.

The GLIAC entered a new era in 1995-96. Previously its members were all institutions located in the state of Michigan. On December 13, 1994, membership was offered to three institutions located in Ohio and Pennsylvania. The expansion members were Ashland University (Ashland, Ohio), Gannon University (Erie, Pa.) and Mercyhurst College (Erie, Pa.). All three began their conference membership July 1, 1995. The University of Findlay (Ohio) was later added to the conference in July of 1997.

Overall the GLIAC conducts championships in 21 sports, 11 for men and 10 for women. Men's championship sports are baseball, basketball, cross country, football, golf, soccer, swimming and diving, tennis, wrestling, indoor track and outdoor track. Women's championship sports include basketball, cross country, golf, soccer, softball, swimming and diving, tennis, indoor track, outdoor track and volleyball.

The policy-making body of the GLIAC is the Executive Council, which is comprised of three representatives from each member institution – its director of athletics, faculty athletics representative and senior women's administrator. Final approval of all GLIAC legislation is required by the Council of GLIAC President's.

The presidency of the GLIAC is rotated alphabetically by school, with Ferris State University Athletics Director Tom Kirinovic serving as the GLIAC President in the 2005-06 athletics season. Wayne State's Rob Fournier holds the role of Past President while Steve Rackley of Findlay is the President-Elect. Tom Brown is in his 14th season as the conference's fifth commissioner and is responsible for all conference administration.

Ferris State University continues to build and remodel a number of campus buildings, including numerous athletic facilities. The result is high-quality facilities which benefit athletes, students and the Big Rapids community.

Encompassed among the many projects on campus was the renovation of the Health and Physical Education (HPE) Building, resulting in the creation of the state-of-the-art Student Recreation Center. Construction, which began in March 1998 and was completed in January 1999, resulted in four multi-use courts, a four-lane elevated track, two aerobic studios, a six-lane, 25-yard pool, a 13-person whirlpool, 40-foot climbing wall, fitness center, free weight room, locker rooms, class rooms and administrative offices.

Figures provided by University Recreation show that more than 1,000 students use the facility daily.

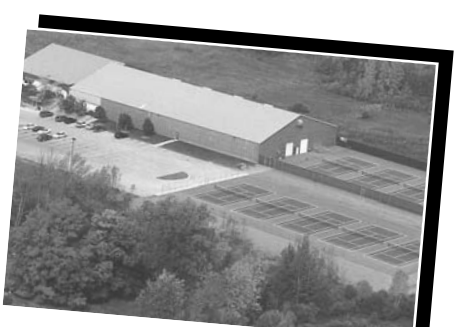
The closure of Jim Wink Arena with the HPE Building meant a move for the varsity men's and women's basketball programs. The result was the 2,400-seat Sports and Convocation Complex, which shares an expanded lobby with the Ewigleben Ice Arena. Construction on the complex was completed in the fall of 1999.

In addition to the new lobby, concessions, pro shop and rest rooms, the Ewigleben Ice Arena features a 4,580 square-foot addition which serves as the home for Bulldog hockey. The locker room, constructed with university funding and money raised by the Bulldog Hockey Pride Committee, includes a student-athlete's lounge, film study room, equipment room, training room, coaches' offices and sauna.

Other Ewigleben Ice Arena improvements at the time included an expanded press box and a hockey locker room for Big Rapids High School.

Katke Golf Course, a university-owned 18-hole course situated on the western side of the Ferris campus, opened a new three-hole practice facility in the spring of 1999. Suggested by the Professional Golfers' Association of America to benefit FSU's Professional Golf Management program, the facility includes an expanded driving range, six target greens and a chipping green with bunkers. Also, a new golf clubhouse was constructed and opened in the summer of 2000.

The many new facilities, supplemented with existing ones such as Ferris State's Racquet and Fitness Center, allow athletes to train and enhance their performance capabilities in the best facilities possible.

Today, Ferris State continues to teach technical skills and applications focused on solving real problems, and produces a career-oriented work force that is prepared to meet the world of high technology.

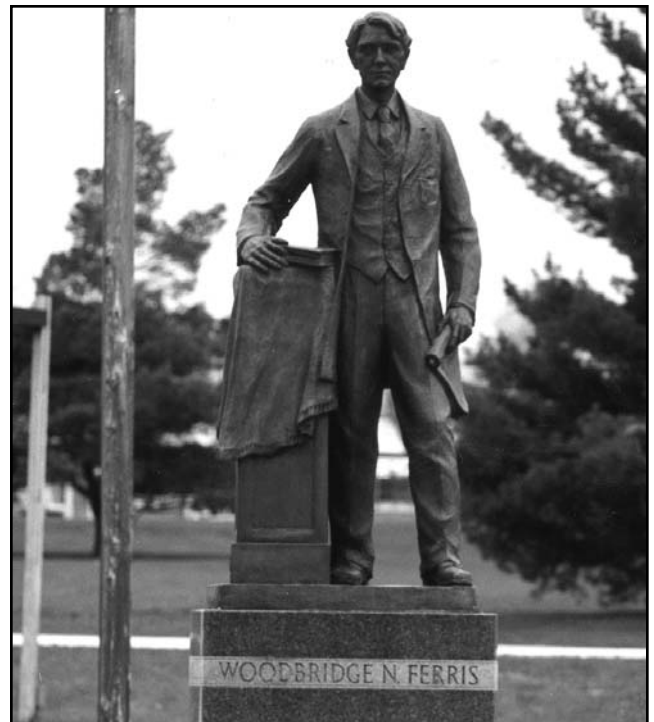
The University offers more than 150 educational programs through the colleges of Allied Health Sciences, Arts and Sciences, Business, Education and Human Services, Kendall College of Art and Design, Michigan College of Optometry, Pharmacy and Technology. The programs are designed to respond to the changing needs of manufacturing, business, health care and other industries and professions which are critical to Michigan's economy.

With a student-to-faculty ratio of approximately 16-1, students at FSU receive the individual attention necessary to prepare them for their careers. Additionally, Ferris boasts a placement rate for graduates of 98 percent, one of the best in Michigan.

Students also have the opportunity to join nearly 200 student organizations on campus plus club, intramural and intercollegiate sports.

The scenic Big Rapids campus is located along the banks of the Muskegon River in the gentle rolling hills of west central Michigan.

Initially, Ferris was known as the Ferris Industrial School, but in 1899 the title was changed to Ferris Institute. It was privately owned and operated until 1931 when it became a non-profit, non-stock education corporation. In 1949, Ferris became a state college, and the school was officially re-named Ferris State College in 1963 and Ferris State University in 1987.

- ▼ Ferris has the largest undergraduate Surveying Engineering program in the U.S. and the only one in Michigan. The program has a 100% placement rate and a starting salary range of \$32-55K
- ▼ The Ferris Pharmacy program is one of 83 nationally and the largest school in Michigan. The job placement rate is 100% with a starting salary range of \$75-95K
- ▼ FSU's Television Production is the only program of its kind in Michigan with an emphasis on professional television. Job placement is 100% with a starting salary range of \$26-30K.
- ▼ Medical Records Administration is the only program of its kind in Michigan. Students consistently exceed the national average on the national boards. Job placement is 100% with 3 to 6 offers per graduate.
- ▼ Ferris' two-year welding technology program is ranked best in the nation with 100% placement and a starting salary range of \$32-40K.
- ▼ In printing management, Ferris has a 100% job placement rate with 15 offers per graduate. Starting salary ranges from \$28,000 to \$40,000.
- ▼ The criminal justice program is one of the largest in Michigan and has a 96% placement rate with a starting salary range of \$30-35+K. Upon graduation, students are certifiable in the state of Michigan.
- ▼ The professional tennis management program, which features a 100% placement rate with a starting salary range of \$30-35K, is one of four in the nation. Upon graduation, students receive a BS in Business Marketing and are USPTA Certified tennis professionals.
- ▼ The Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration (HVACR) Technology program is the only four-year program in Michigan and is one of two nationally. The program boasts a 100% job placement rate with 25 offers per graduate and a starting salary range of \$41-71K. The HVACR, which will open in the fall of 2003, will triple the current facilities size.
