The original cows brought to the ranch were out of three different bloodlines. M-line, Custer, and Durham. These animals were the original seed stock for the herd. Today, we have used those animals and an excellent selection of bulls to raise stock cows that have the traits and genetics we continue to strive for.

Today, Lee and Rebecca, along with their son Kevin and his wife Anne, continue to expand the ranch for the next generation.



# Young Guns Yearling Breeding Bull Challenge Girlz Going Wild Yearling Heifer Challenge

The heifers and bulls began arriving at Heartland Bison Ranch the first week in April of 2018. By the middle of April, all animals had arrived at the ranch and the groups spent the remainder of the time acclimating to their new surrounding and in their new groups. During this period, the heifers had access to clean water, fresh quality prairie hay and range cake two times per week. The bulls had access to a self-feeder with six tons of ration to help them regain weight lost during transport. They also had clean water access and fresh prairie hay. The animals spent approximately four weeks together in this phase before being worked for turn out.

On May 19, both the heifers and bulls were worked for turn out on grass. At that point, both groups were weighed and given a Dectomax, Mycoplasma, and Once PMH nasal vaccine. Our ranch received significant moisture through June and the animals really benefited from the abundant grass. On July 5, we received our last significant rainfall for the remainder of the summer. The animals were still on ample grass and receiving a small amount of range cake, two pounds per head per week to keep them trained to the truck. With range conditions changing quickly, we made the decision in mid-August to bring in the bulls on August 25 and collect their weights for ADG on grass at exactly 100 days. At this time, they also received a Dectomax injectable wormer. We would also point out that the bulls did not receive any type of pellet or feed supplement while on grass except for access to Redmond 418 Bison Mineral.

Once on feed, the bulls had access to three self-feeders and two large hay feeders throughout their feed test. The bison ration used was 14.1% protein and the prairie hay was sourced from the same field. The pen that these bulls spent time in was built this summer specifically for the Young Guns group and we believe the bulls benefited from the clean ground and ample space.

While the bulls progressed through their feed test, the heifers continued grazing on the range until they were brought in on November 3. They were weighed to determine their ADG on grass at 166 days and given a Dectomax injectable wormer. The heifers were then sent out to a small 15-acre pasture where they had access to a self-feeder and bale grazed until the sale work up. The total time heifers had access to a feed ration was 60 days. The comments we got from the ultrasound technician were that these heifers are very lean and the fat cover they do have is consistent across the board for the group.

The bulls were brought in on December 3 to weigh in for the ADG feed test portion of the competition. The feed test was calculated at exactly 100 days and total gain was based on the 200 days of total test time between grass and feed. After weighing in the bulls, they returned to their same location with feed and hay access until the sale work up.

Both the bulls and heifers were brought through the chute on January 2 for their sale weigh-in, vet testing and checkup and ribeye ultrasound. The final run through took place on January 5 and all sale animals were again given a Detomax injectable as well as a Mycoplasma vaccination.

Overall, we believe that animals available at this sale represent one of the top groups of breeding stock in North America this sale season. We would like to thank each consignor for putting their trust in our operation and we look forward to a strong sale for these animals on February 2!

### About the Dakota Territory Buffalo Assn.

- The DTBA was established in 1996 and is based in Rapid City, SD.
- The DTBA has nearly 200 members representing 14 states, including South Dakota, North Dakota, Colorado, Minnesota, Nebraska, Wyoming, Wisconsin, Texas, Indiana, South Carolina, Oklahoma, New Mexico, Kansas and California.
- South Dakota is the largest buffalo producing state in the US, with more buffalo than the next two biggest states combined. North Dakota, Montana, and Nebraska are the next largest producing states.
- The DTBA is a member of the National Bison Association, based in Denver, Colorado. The association also shares membership with our sister association, the North Dakota Buffalo Association and is a lifetime member of the Montana Bison Association.
- The DTBA hosted the 2007 International Bison Conference in Rapid City, SD and to date that was one of the most successful IBC events anywhere.
- The DTBA was the first group to develop a carcass contest based on real market conditions. Additionally, the group was the first, and is still the only, group that conducts a carcass contest for heifers.
- Custer State Park has a herd of approximately 1300 buffalo and is an active member of the association and partners with the group on many projects.
- DTBA also works with the InterTribal Buffalo Council, other state and regional buffalo groups, the National Bison Association, the Canadian Bison Association and partners on projects with other like-minded organizations.
- The DTBA Black Hills Buffalo Classic Show and Sale, featuring the group's Young Guns Yearling Breeding Bull Challenge and the Girlz Gone Wild Two Year Old Bred Heifer Challenge, is currently one of the most successful live buffalo auctions in the country. In 2015, the sale had the highest selling bull and the highest average in the country on yearling breeding bulls and the second highest average in the country on two year old bred heifers and tied for the highest selling two year old bred heifer in the country. The Girlz Gone Wild program is the only one of its kind in the country.
- The DTBA Winter Conference is always the last weekend of the Black Hills Stock Show and Rodeo, which will be celebrating its 61st year in 2019. With an estimated attendance of 331,000, this is the second largest event in the state of South Dakota, with only the Sturgis Motorcycle Rally boasting more attendees.




