Children's Services Reopening COVID-19 Guidelines & Protocols

Children's Programming Babysitting Services

- Resume operations June 1, 2021
- Babysitting Hours (EEHF Naperville & Seven Bridges)
 - Monday thru Friday
 - 8am – 12pm
 - 3:30 pm – 6:30 pm
 - Saturdays
 - 8 am – 12 pm
- Reservations required for planning/adherence to room limits and a means of contact tracing
- No outside food or drink allowed

Children's Programming Babysitting Services

- **General Information & Rules**

- Reservations are required to assure adequate staffing.
- Advance reservations required
- Reservations may be made for 30, 60 or 90 minutes, one visit per day per child. 630-646-7940 Seven Bridges or 630-646-5950 Naperville
- Cancellation of a reservation must be made at least two hours in advance to avoid a "late cancellation" charge. Failure to cancel will result in a "no show" fee of \$5.00
- For health and sanitation reasons, our team members will not change diapers. Changing tables are located in kidzone. You will be paged or we will locate you in the club, if your child needs changing. If their clothes are wet or soiled, a change of clothes must be put on before the child returns to Kidzone/Adventure Center.
- No child will be permitted in Child Care if any of the following conditions exist: runny nose, deep cough, diarrhea, rash, elevated temperature, red eyes or eye discharge. Your child must be free of these symptoms, unmedicated, for 72 hours before returning.
- A physician's note may be required for any conditions or allergies that are being treated and declared harmless.

- **During Your Visit**

- All staff & children (Ages 2 and older) will be wearing masks.
- We will be asking general health questions and taking temperatures of all staff and members upon entry. Any temperature of 100.4 or higher will be denied access.
- Child Care will print a name tag for your child. Please let us know your location and activity in the club and if your child has any special needs or requirements.
- Based on social distancing requirements, storing strollers in Kidzone is not possible at this time. Thank you for your understanding.
- No food or drink allowed at this time.
- All persons entering Kidzone or Adventure Center must use hand sanitizer or wash hands before entry.
- Gym shoes required for Adventure Center/Gym play

Keeping kids safe

- Kidzone & Adventure Center
- Health Screening, Cleaning & Sanitation Processes & Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Hand Sanitizers are located at the entrance and throughout the Child Care areas. Everyone upon entering Child Care must use hand sanitizer and also when exiting the area.
- Everyone (2 years and older) will be required to wear a mask.
- We will be taking temperatures of all staff and guests upon entry
- Staff will continue to practice physical distancing (when possible), more frequent handwashing/sanitizing.
- Continuous cleaning of baby equipment, toys, board games, art supplies, using Triple S Renegade Disinfectant & Viricide.
- Continuous scheduled cleaning of frequently touched surfaces, communication devices and restrooms/diaper changing stations Triple S Renegade Disinfectant & Viricide wipes.
- Anyone who exhibits symptoms of illness are being asked to stay at home.
- Kidzone/Adventure Center will be deep cleaned nightly by our overnight cleaning crews in accordance with EEHF COVID-19 protocol.

- Edward Elmhurst Health & Fitness asks all families & staff who are displaying any fever or flu like symptoms to please refrain from entering the club until they are symptom free.

Notification of members if COVID-19 positive case

- Internal posting indicating the date the infected person attended or worked at the fitness center
- Management staff will notify any parties impacted using staff schedules/reservation log sheets
- Executive Director to notify DCFS/IDPH
- Post internal signage that families are to immediately notify EEHF if someone in their home has tested positive or has had close contact (less than 6 feet for longer than 15 minutes) with a positive case
- Families must notify EEHF immediately if anyone in household tests positive for COVID-19 and child has been in our facility 48 hours prior
