FALL LEAF COLLECTION - TOWN OF OROMOCTO6 - 17 November 2017

In an effort to divert the volume of waste materials from the landfill, the Town will offer a leaf curbside collection of all residential households.

Acceptable Materials

Leaves ONLY in clear polyethylene plastic bags of 1.5 ml thickness with a maximum capacity of 55 litres securely tied at the top and not exceeding 20 kg (44 lbs) per bag.

Please <u>do not</u> place leaves at curbside in advance of 6 November and not after 17 November.
