

The class consists of one intensive day of teaching, tasting and a 45 minute multiple-choice examination.

What is included in your fee: All study materials, a full day of intensive lectures and tasting of 8 to 10 wines, ISO tasting glasses provided, external examination paper sent from and marked by WSET UK, certificate and lapel pin, postage and sundries, WSET global accreditation.

The WSET Level 2 in Wines and Spirits is intended for those with a little previous experience in the field of wine and spirits. Particularly suited to those in the hospitality or wine trade fields, this course will also appeal to avid wine lovers seeking a comprehensive understanding of the subject. The course consists of 3 consecutive days of intensive lectures and guided tastings of around 50 wines, with the 60 minute examination held on the final afternoon.

What is included in your fee: All study materials, 3 full days of intensive lectures and tasting of 50 wines, ISO tasting glasses provided, external examination paper sent from and marked by WSET UK, certificate and lapel pin, postage and sundries, WSET global accreditation.

This qualification is open to students who hold the WSET Level 2 Award in Wines & Spirits or can demonstrate the equivalent level of knowledge. It is recommended that students complete the Level 2 Award in Wines & Spirits before progressing to the Level 3 course.

What is included in the course fee: All study materials, 5 full days of intensive lectures and tasting of up to 90 wines, ISO tasting glasses provided, external written and tasting examination papers sent from and marked by WSET UK, certificate and lapel pin, postage and sundries, WSET global accreditation.

Full payment must accompany the booking form – we do not accept provisional bookings and places will only be confirmed once payment is received. Cancellation of Courses by Sirromet Wine Education Training:

- Occasionally, due to unforeseen circumstances, a scheduled course may have to be cancelled by Sirromet Wine Education Training.
- Affected students will be notified immediately in the event of cancellation of their course. Students will be offered either a place in a later course if available, or a refund of their course fees.
- If study materials have already been issued at the time of cancellation, then study materials must be returned in a reusable, unmarked condition for a full refund, otherwise the cost of study materials will be deducted from any refund issued.

Cancellation of Enrolment / Requests for Transfers by Student:

Due to the intensive style presentation model of the WSET courses taught at Sirromet Wine Education Training, and the requirement (particularly for Level 2 and Level 3) for students to have sufficient private study time prior to the commencement of the course, it may not be possible to fill places that arise because of enrolled students cancelling their enrolment. Due to this constraint, our cancellation/refund policy is specific to the Level of WSET Award Course:

Level 1 Award in Wines:

- Cancellations up until 21 days prior to the start of the course course fees will be refunded to the payee, minus a cancellation fee of \$50 and the cost of study materials if already issued (\$35).
- Cancellations within 21 days of the course date there will be no refund of fees.
- Requests for transfer (to a later course) up until 21 days prior to the start of the course may be granted subject to availability of places, with payment of a \$50 administration fee.
- Requests for transfer within 21 days of the course date will only be granted in certain circumstances (i.e. illness with a medical certificate). The \$50 administration fee will apply, and if examination papers have already been ordered an examination transfer fee of \$100 will also apply.

Level 2 Award in Wines and Spirits:

- Cancellations up until 60 days prior to the start of the course course fees will be refunded to the payee, minus a cancellation fee of \$50 and the cost of study materials if already issued (\$70).
- Cancellation between 60 and 30 days prior to the start of the course a 50% refund will apply, after the cancellation fee of \$50 and cost of study materials has been deducted.
- Cancellations within 30 days of the course starting date there will be no refund of fees.
- Requests for transfer (to a later course) up until 30 days prior to the start of the course may be granted subject to availability of places, with payment of a \$50 administration fee.
- Requests for transfer within 30 days of the course date will only be granted in certain circumstances (i.e. illness with a medical certificate). The \$50 administration fee will apply, and if examination papers have already been ordered an examination transfer fee of \$100 will also apply.





Level 3 Award in Wines:

- Cancellations up until 90 days prior to the start of the course course fees will be refunded to the payee, minus a cancellation fee of \$100 and the cost of study materials if already issued (\$125).
- Cancellation between 90 and 30 days prior to the start of the course a 50% refund will apply, after the cancellation fee of \$100 and cost of study materials has been deducted.
- Cancellations within 30 days of the course starting date there will be no refund of fees.
- Requests for transfer (to a later course) up until 60 days prior to the start of the course may be granted subject to availability of places, with payment of a \$100 administration fee.
- Requests for transfer within 60 days of the course date will only be granted in certain circumstances (i.e. illness with a medical certificate). The \$100 administration fee will apply, and if examination papers have already been ordered an examination transfer fee of \$100 will also apply.
