

# From The Pastor



There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in all.

Ephesians 4:4-6

#### One Church

What does it take to make us one church? This might be a question that requires some thought as well as some discussion. To be one church does not mean that we all have to think alike. Nor does it mean that our individuality is denounced so that we can belong to a group. If we just go back to the twelve (12) disciples who walked with Jesus, we immediately

recognize that they were all very different.

They came from different families. They had different occupations. They did not all form their conclusions in the same way. But they all followed Jesus in the ministry that they shared. Even when they didn't fully understand Jesus, what he was doing, why he went to certain places or why he associated with some of the people that he associated with. But they all worked together and became the foundation of the Christian faith.

Even with all their doubts, misgivings, arguments and times of fear, they trusted in God and Jesus, and by the guidance and presence of the Holy Spirit they moved towards the unity that was necessary for God to accomplish through them what was needed by the people of their time. And so it will be with us.

Those who followed Jesus and followed after him believed that the work that they were called to do was ordained by God and that God had chosen them to serve the widows and orphans, to visit the sick, to bring healing to those who were ill, to give voices to those who could not speak for themselves, to walk with the lame until they could walk alone and to bind up the broken hearted and to include in their circle those who had been rejected and set aside.

We too have learned how to do those things that Jesus taught so that we can and we do include all people in the ministries that we share. Our gifts and abilities are different and we have them in varying degrees. But we have all received them by the grace and favor of God. And it is up to us to use our gifts, to honor the One who gave them to us.

We recognize that all good things come from God and so we honor God by taking the very skills that we have and putting them to use in service to God and each other. The very creeds and prayers that we say reference the God that we proclaim as the creator of all things and the author and giver of all life. Thus we recognize and respect each other and the gifts and talents that we use to glorify the God that we serve.

We proclaim a fellowship with each other because through baptism we have joined and been joined to a family of believers who lift up the name of Jesus, believe in his teachings and commit ourselves to love and to serve others just as we want to be loved and served. We do not do these things to be recognized or praised by other people. But we do them in obedience to the command of God through a Jesus Christ to "love our neighbor as we love ourselves." At one point Jesus asked, can we say that we love God whom we have not seen and hate our brothers and sisters who we have seen?

Our expressions of love then must go out to all people, not just the people with whom we share names, living spaces or communities. Our actions must include those communities. Our actions must include those who are in need, not just those who look like us or dress like us or talk like us or live in the same communities that we live in. We are called by Christ to reach out to others as we serve in his name.

As we reflect on the opening text for this dialog, I pray that God will open our minds and help us to be of the "one body and one Spirit just as we have been called to the one hope of our calling," by the "one Lord, one faith and one above all and through all."

I ask you to join with me again for 2020 and make St. Andrew-One Church-where all are welcomed and God receives the honor and praise for all that happens with us, through us and by us. I ask that we all might pray for God's blessings upon St. Andrew so that our hope for the future might become the beacon of light that goes out into the community around us and draws people into a closer relationship with God and others through the ministry that we share.

Let us pray,

Dear God, move us as one church whose mission it is to express your love through us to all that we encounter and in all that we do.

#### 2019 Wrap-Up / 2020 Kick-Off Activities

We closed the 2019 financial church year with a net cash flow deficit of \$10,390. This simply means that our 2019 Giving was short or our cash needs (for expenses and mortgage premiums) by \$10,390.

The following schedule may be help better understand our yearend results.

We have available funds to cover this shortfall and your Council has already taken action to address this. We will need to address concerns with overall Giving with our 2020 Budget planning.

As we move into 2020 there are a number of planning and service opportunities that will happen in January and February:

- Our Annual Congregational Meeting will be held on Sunday, February 9, 2020 following the 10:30am Worship Service. Please make plans to attend as we need everyone's input and participation.
- 2019 Annual Report will be reviewed at the Annual Congregational Meeting in February. The report should be available for distribution later in January
- In January we will be asking for your inputs on Giving Commitments as we finalize our 2020 Budget detail.
- We will submit the 2020 Budget at the Congregational Meeting for your consideration and approval. If you have any inputs and/or questions about our financial planning please contact Amy Lemire or me before the scheduled meeting.
- New Council Members will be elected during the Congregational Meeting in Feb. If you have been a St. Andrew member for 3 years and would be willing to service on Council, please contact Amy Lemire, Pastor McKiver, Gerald Stout or me about being on the Council Members ballot.

If you have any questions or suggestions regarding any of the upcoming actions, or you just wish to express your concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me, any of your Council Members, or Pastor McKiver. We welcome your inputs and feedback.

I ask your continued commitment to Giving and your ongoing prayers for our church as we strive to support St. Andrew Lutheran, our worship opportunities and our ministries at home and beyond. May God continue to bless our church and congregation.
