

2019 has been an exciting year for 5/6B! In Term 3, Year 5 headed off to Morisset Active Camp for 4 days. The students were eager to try new activities including archery, rock climbing, fencing, high ropes and the list goes on. They enjoyed being grouped with other students from MPS and worked together in many activities. One of the highlights was the commando night, where MPS teachers and students battled to see who would be victorious.

Another highlight for 5/6B was our annual school Book Week Parade. The students participated in a STEM challenge, where they worked in groups to design and build a catapult. It was great to see so many parents and grandparents visiting our classroom.

In Term 3, we started to read the novel "Bridge to Terabithia". The students loved reading about Jesse and Leslie. We have nearly finished our book so we will be comparing it to the movie. In writing, we have been working on VCOP. The students have enjoyed learning about up-levelling their writing. We are currently researching facts about recycling. The students are using IT resources to write a persuasive text on recycling. These texts will be displayed in our google classroom and can be viewed at home.

#### GEOGRAPHY - SCIENCE - CAPA

This term in Geography, 5/6B and 5/6H are learning about how people are connected to the environment. We will be investigating how town planning is affected by the environment and we will be building our own towns. Last term, Stage 3 studied the solar system and we are now designing and building a Mars rover model. This term in CAPA, the students will be performing acts from fairy tales using puppets.

Year 6 will be heading to the High School shortly for transition days, open nights and uniform fittings. Year 5 will also attend some transition sessions. #### Intention to apply for Year 7 entry to a selective high school in 2021

Dear Parent/Carer.

Selective high schools cater for academically high potential and gifted students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates of their own academic standard. Selective schools help these students to learn by grouping them with students of similar ability, using specialised teaching methods and materials.

Selective high schools are unzoned so parents can apply regardless of where they live. Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 12 March 2020.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2021, you need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available from late-September 2019 at <a href="https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7">https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7</a>.

The application website opens at that link on 8 October 2019 and closes at 10pm on 11 November 2019. You must apply before the closing date.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Unit for assistance after 8 October 2019.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.

Remember: the tear-off slip below is NOT an application and the school cannot apply on your behalf.
