

Epistle

they will all wear out like a garment,


¹²like a robe you will roll them up,

Holy Gospel

C I believe in one God,


the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible.

▶ For the destitute, those recovering from natural disaster and those who find themselves in want, that they would receive the necessities for daily life, that the agencies who serve them would receive generous support, and that those who serve and those who are served would come to see God as the Giver of daily bread, Lord, in your mercy,

■ In thanksgiving for all the people of God who have gone before us and now rest in His presence, that we, too, would be kept faithful until that day when He makes all things new, Lord, in your mercy,

C hear our prayer.



The Words of Our Lord




