Tarot cards will make your decision for you. No, you have free will, and it is up to you to decide. My Favourite Questions to Ask the Tarot ... To help you stay in this beautiful place of curiosity, empowerment, and manifestation, here are some of my favourite questions to ask the cards: ... What do I need to know about this situation? ... What is the energy surrounding this situation? ... How can I achieve my desired outcome? ... Over time, you'll find your favourites too. ... Once you have your question, write it down, so it's clear in your mind. STEP 3. SHUFFLE AND LAY OUT THE CARDS Now you're ready to pick up your cards and shuffle. As you do, channel your energy into the reading and focus on your question. Then, when you feel ready, lay out the cards for your reading. Lay them side by side, from left to right, face up. 430 | A Quick Start Guide to Reading Tarot for Yourself STEP 4: READ THE CARDS AND ANSWER YOUR QUESTION This is the fun part! Go through each card, from left to right, and interpret what it means for you. Use the techniques you learned to read each card intuitively, writing your insights as you go. And if you need a little extra support, consult your favourite Tarot guide to discover the traditional meaning of the card. Remember, though, only look at the book after you have explored the card intuitively. Once you have interpreted each card, look at the whole spread as if it were a three-page storybook. What's the story the cards are telling you? Now go back to your original question and answer it based on what you have explored within the cards. Write the complete reading in your notebook, including the question you asked, the cards, your interpretations and your answer. Come back to these insights later to reflect and learn from what transpired after the reading. And, voilà, you're done! How to Tell the Story in an Entire Reading Whether you're using a three-card spread or a ten-card spread, it's possible to create meaningful connections and tell the story in an entire reading. Here's how: 1. Tell the story in each card. 2. Look for meaningful combinations and tell the combined story. 3. Look for key themes and patterns across all the cards in the reading. 4. Pay attention to the balance of Minor and Major Arcana cards, Suits, and Numbers. 5. Look for the Major Arcana cards. What is the story connecting these cards? And how do the other Minor Arcana cards support this story? 6. Bring together what you have discovered and write the story of the reading. Remember to start small. Begin by telling the story across a three-card reading. As your confidence grows, so can the size of your spreads. Soon you'll be able to read the story within a more complex spread like the ten-card Celtic Cross! THE ULTIMATE GUIDE TO TAROT CARD MEANINGS | 431 Help! Do you need help with your reading? Here are a few commons situations that come up when people read the cards for themselves and what to do about them. My Reading Makes Little Sense! Sometimes you may find that there are messages in the cards that make little sense. It doesn't mean the reading is wrong. It may just be a sign that you're not ready for the message just yet. Note down your insights even if you don't understand them. Then come back to your reading in a week or a month to see if it takes on new strength for you. Sometimes events need to unfold further before a reading resonates. It's Not What I Want to Hear Sometimes you may receive a message that is challenging to hear. For example, the cards may show that there are deep-seated issues in what you thought was a dreamy relationship. Go back to why you asked about your relationship. Perhaps your subconscious mind knew something was up, but it's taking your conscious mind a little longer to catch up. Get curious and open up to exploring whatever comes up in a reading, even the darker shadows. If the cards are showing you something you haven't realised yet, be ready to go deeper and ask what it's all about. Draw more Tarot cards if you need a little more support. Am I Just Making This Up? Sometimes you may receive a positive message and wonder if you're just making it up or if it's your intuition doing the talking. (It's funny how we can't always embrace our own success!) If you do the work up front to clear your mind and connect with your inner wisdom, then your reading will reflect your intuition, rather than your ego. But understanding how to use them to connect with your intuition and your inner wisdom is another. Your inner wisdom is where the magic happens, where your real power shines through, and you start to create a whole new way of living inspired by your Highest Self and your soul purpose. It's time to tap into it. Here's the thing – in this book, I've walked you through each and every Tarot card and have shown you what I perceive to be the energy and meaning of each card. But is this the 'be all and end all' of Tarot card meanings? No way! There are two ways of interpreting the Tarot cards: 1. From the book with traditional meanings 2. From the heart with intuitive meanings Traditional card meanings do serve a purpose. They connect us to the collective wisdom and history of the Tarot and provide the backbone of what the Tarot cards refer to. You'll find them in Tarot books and websites like my own [www.biddytarot.com](http://www.biddytarot.com), and they often link to deeper symbolic and esoteric systems. Intuitive card meanings serve a different purpose. For example, you see the Moon card in a reading about reaching a goal, and you're reminded of the phrase, "Shoot for the moon." With enough practice, you'll be able to tap into both the traditional and intuitive meanings in a Tarot reading, knowing when to use one or the other. Don't rely on just one method! The cards are slightly smaller than average Tarot cards, fitting perfectly into your palm and purse for easy shuffling and transport. Gaian Tarot by Joanna Powell ( This is a beautiful, healing deck with imagery that is easy to read and interpret. It's got a very soulful, earthy, and grounded energy. And the guidebook is one of the best out there. Lumina Tarot by Inner Hue ( This gorgeous deck melds animal magick, archetypal energy and symbolism together in potent visual imagery that will support you in accessing your own intuitive abilities. It comes with a 185-page guidebook and offers both yin & yang, light & shadow. Naked Heart Tarot by Jillian C. Wilde ( An intuitive deck that encourages you to tap into your spirit guides, animal totems and angels for a deeper connection. The imagery is exquisite and full of magic.
