

Gassho Reiki Hands (palms slightly apart)







"Gassho" 合掌 - the first kanji 合" ga(t)" means 'to put together' and the second kanji 掌 "sho/shou" means 'palm' as in "shoutei"(palm strike) so "gassho" means to put both palms together. The stress (accent) should be on "sho".

In Japan, "gassho" means "praying hands". Japanese people do "gassho' when they pray to Buddha. Japanese children are taught to do "gassho" before and after eating which is to show appreciation for the food. Japanese people don't "gassho" when they say 'thank you', though ... Thai people do.

In Reiki, we hold our palms slightly apart so that we can feel the Reiki energies strongly.



Approach: Usui Teate Reiki

- Level 1 Practitioner Shoden
 - Learn to use the Reiki symbol
 - · Understand the meaning of kanji for Reiki
 - · Learn to intone and project the Kotodama: REI-KI
 - Practice physical Reiki (people, objects, places, food)
 - Learn hand positions, but no touching!
 - · Memorize *Gokai Sansho* (Reiki Prayer) in *Japanese*
 - Learn and practice twice daily the Hatsu Rei Ho (Reiki's only daily ritual)
 - · Project: Create a *Reiki Box*



What Is Reiki?

- Two concepts define Reiki:
 - 1 it's Universal life-force, zero-point energy.
 - 2 it's an energyworking healing modality.
- Two precepts guide ethical Reiki practice:
 - 1 Receiver must consent to receive Reiki.
 - 2 there must be an energy exchange.







Lineage: Ancient Japanese Reiki



Mikao Usui (Usui Sensei) is Founder of the Usui System of Natural Healing. Divined it while in meditation at monastery at Mt. Kurama. Incorporated Shinto and Buddhist aspects to Reiki healing art because he was a Tendai Buddhist monk.

Taught **Usui Teate** in Japan. Meaning: "Usui's Healing Hand". Established Usui Shiki Reiki Ryoho Gakkai (1922).

Usui's official designated successor was **not** Dr. Hayashi. **J. Ushida (Ushida Sensei)** was Usui's designated successor.

Ushida Sensei's lineage of students are the practitioners from the Gakkai at Mt. Kurama Temple.

Chris Marsh, the only Westerner allowed to learn Usui Reiki from the Gakkai, was given permission to teach Hiroshi Doi and Steven Taggert, who then brought Usui Teate Reiki to America.

Lineage: Westernized Reiki





Dr. Chujiro Hayashi, one of Usui Sensei's students. A respected practitioner in his own right, he called his style **Usui Shiki Ryoho Reiki** in homage to Usui Sensei. Conducted his own Reiki clinic apart from Usui Sensei's school. A Christian, he did not propagate spiritual aspects of Usui's Reiki.

Mrs. Hawayo Takata from Kaua'i, Hawai'i, went to Japan seeking Reiki for health reasons and was directed to Dr. Hayashi's clinic. Dr. Hayashi cured her, then she wanted to learn his methods. As his primary student, Hayashi Sensei attuned her as a Reiki Master. Mrs. Tanaka trained with Hayashi for 32 years before returning to Hawai'i. She propagated Hayashi's Usui Shiki Ryoho Reiki (USRR) in America at \$10K per level. She never allowed written notes to be taken and claimed she was the last legitimate Reiki master in the world. In keeping with Dr. Hayashi's Christian background, Mrs. Tanaka propagated USRR as the Reiki style Western practitioners know without the spiritual aspects of Usui Sensei's original teachings.

Approach: Western Reiki

- · Level 1 Practitioner:
 - Project Reiki through physical touch
 - Practice touching physical objects (person, places or things)



- · Learn hand positions on various parts of the body
- Practice with a partner (this is how Reiki-shares originated)
- · Learn the Reiki Prayer































Usui Shiki Ryoho Reiki – Level One

Administering Reiki directed to the body. Hand Positions on the Recipient require a light touch only.

You can also administer Reiki to yourself using similar hand positions, illustrated on the next slide.

Gokai Sansho ("Reiki Prayer")

FOR TODAY ONLY ... Do not Anger **Do not Worry** Be Grateful and do your work with appreciation For this is spiritual awakening. Be kind to all Living Things. In the morning and at night, With hands held in prayer: Think this with your Mind, **Chant this with your Mouth, and Keep good intentions in your Heart.**



"You will receive the Western information for historical perspective, but the main focus is teaching **Usui Teate** in the Original way. In the west, we don't have the dedication or time to be trained week after week as it was originally taught, so this system has been brought up to date making adjustments to modern times.

You will be one of the few who have been taught like this and as such you will be receiving up to date knowledge and techniques which are generally not known in the west."

. Syllabus: Shoden (Level 1)

Daily Practice:

- · Practice twice daily the *Hatsu Rei Ho*
- · Meditate on the meaning of Reiki kanji



- · Intone the Kotodama: REI KI
- · Practice hand positions: people, objects, places, food
- No touching client when practicing your techniques
- · Memorize **Gokai Sansho** (Reiki Prayer)
- · Journal your Reiki experiences, messages
- · Project: Reiki Box







Knowing The Reiki Symbol

- Western Reiki practitioners overlook the actual word – Reiki – as a generative energy source.
- Ancient Cymatics: Reiki characters (kanji) is a Level 1 kotodama (sound key) to be used alongside the hand positions.
- The esoteric understanding underlying the brushstrokes of the *kanji* is intended as a visualization tool and approach to applying Reiki energy to physical objects.



Meaning of the Reiki Symbol



REI = Spirit; Energy from the Universe

Straight line across the top: Under heaven; spirit; soul; life-force energy from above (the Heavens).

Second horizontal line (and 4 lines under it): Clouds and rain.

Vertical Line: Bringing the life-force, spiritual energy down from Heaven through clouds of illusion.

<u>Gestures – Horizontal Line</u>: Under Heaven. The two figures are Shaman/Magicians.

Vertical Line: Connecting Heaven & Earth ("as above, so below").

Bottom Horizontal Line: Earth. Through the dance the Shaman are connecting Heaven and Earth, bringing down the blessings of Heaven.

KI = Mana, Life Energy



Two Horizontal Lines: Moisture vapor penetrated by life force energy.

Horizontal/Vertcal Line: Earth's crust & Seed. Life force energy penetrates Earth and is absorbed by the Seed, which then explodes with growth.

Whole Body Reiki

- To achieve better relaxation
- For removing toxin and blocked
- To restore general condition of the body
- To cope up with anxiety and depression
- To reduce side effects of medicine
- Works as a complimentary system of treatment



Healing Approach – Usui Teate

Usui Teate Reiki – Shoden (Level One) To direct your Reiki, use the same hand positions as illustrated in the previous slide.

- **1.** You begin and end every session with the *Hatsu Rei Ho.*
- 2. You intone the kotodama: REI-KI
- **3.** Your hands are held above the body only; no touching the client.
- **4.** After treatment has completed, break the *'aka* cords by washing your hands with cold water.

- Kyo Dake Wa
 - Key-YO DAH-kay Wah
- · Shinpai Su Na
 - shin-PYE SUE Nah
- Kanashite
 - Kah-NAHSHH-tay
- Gyo Wo Hage Me
 - GYOH woh HA-geh meh
- Hito Ni Shinsetsu Ni
 - HEE-toh NEE shin-SET-suh NEE

Your Reiki Box



- Not a wish box
- Place names/items inside this box
- Infuse the box with Reiki to immediately send healing to everyone inside it.
- Keep on your Altar.

Twice-Daily Ritual: Hatsu Rei Ho

- · Sit upright, breathe naturally, relaxation ritual
- Brush off old energy cords (from sleep, outside)
 - Arms, Torso, Neck and Crown of Head
- · Raise arms above head, palms upward
- Feel tingling from attunement energies in palms
- Bring down hands to <u>Gassho</u> at chest/heart
- · Create crystal blue chi ball pulsing hands together
- · Recite Gokai Sansho
- Exhale, then as you inhale, press chi ball into solar plexus (tan tien), then inhale to "eat" the chi ball.
- · Ready for meditation, healing and attunement







Attunement – Shoden/Level 1


