Welcome to North Park Covenant Church online! We're glad you're here.

From the Treasurer: Thank you! Your ongoing giving to North Park Covenant Church is greatly appreciated! Through March, our envelope offering income is about \$133,000, slightly behind the budgeted amount of \$143,000 but in line with prior years. And the giving in March was not noticeably lower than the earlier months this year. Thank you for your continued support of our people and ministries. Some of our other income components are down slightly, like loose offerings and building rental, and that is not surprising in current life events. Total income is \$163,000. Our expenses (\$181,000) are higher than income, but they are below our expected budgeted expenses (\$190,000).
