INTRODUCTION

West Chester University offers a variety of degree programs with a mission of preparing learners with the tools for successful lives in an increasingly complex world. West Chester's workforce region¹ is experiencing change in terms of demographics, industry growth, and occupational demand. West Chester's workforce region has a population of 4.7 million. By 2026, the region's population is expected to increase 2 percent. However, the number of individuals under the age of 30 is projected to decline by 3.3 percent during the same period. Additionally, West Chester's workforce region supports approximately 2.3 million jobs.² The number of jobs in the region is projected to grow by 5.9 percent by 2026. More noteworthy is the growth for skilled occupations, which is projected to be even higher, growing by 6.7 percent during the same period.³

As the economy and society change, the profile of students applying to and attending West Chester also changes. As such, the need to critically assess and understand these changes at West Chester will aid in identifying enrollment goals and strategies for attracting highly qualified students from all backgrounds. Applications, admissions, and enrollment trends reflect the outcome of these changes.

This Admissions Report describes three themes and admissions perspectives, specifically:

- The pipeline of applicants to West Chester University.
- The characteristics of those accepted.
- The enrollment decisions of accepted applicants.

The analysis of these key themes addresses several research questions, most notably:

- What proportions of accepted applicants enroll at West Chester?
- If students are accepted but do not enroll, where do they go?
- What are the demographic, socioeconomic, and educational backgrounds of accepted and enrolled applicants?

Additionally, key information and data provided in the appendix address other research questions, such as:

- What are the origins of the accepted and enrolled applicants (e.g. high school)?
- Who are the competitor universities?
- Which State System universities enrolled West Chester accepted applicants?

This report serves as a first step in gaining deeper insight into admissions and enrollment at West Chester and within the State System. This information will enable informed discussions regarding strategic activities for recruitment, admissions, and enrollment to help fulfill West Chester's mission.

¹ University Workforce regions were developed by the State System to display the interconnectedness of local economies surrounding the State System universities using workforce commuting patterns and economic activity data. West Chester University's workforce region includes Chester, Bucks, Delaware, Montgomery, Philadelphia, and New Castle (DE) counties.

³ Skilled occupations are defined as those occupations in O*NET Job Zones Three, Four, or Five. These occupations are typically associated with postsecondary education requirements.

FINDINGS

West Chester University's admissions data⁴ includes all first-time students who are seeking a bachelor's degree, an associate degree, or a certificate. This report presents an overview of those students who applied to West Chester for summer/fall 2017, those who were accepted, and those who enrolled (Table 1). National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) data was used to determine if a student enrolled at an institution other than West Chester University during the fall 2017 semester.⁵

General Findings

- Overall, West Chester had decreasing applications, increasing acceptances, along with increasing enrollments. By comparison, the State System experienced increasing applications, increasing acceptances, but faced decreasing enrollments.
- West Chester accepted 74 percent of its applicants in 2018 (Table 1), as compared to a State System average of 87 percent. West Chester's acceptance rate increased 10 percentage points (pp) since 2016.

- Sixty-five percent of West Chester accepted applicants enrolled at another State System university or a Non-System institution, an increase from 66 percent in 2016 (Table 2).
- About 53 percent of Pennsylvania applicants accepted by West Chester enrolled at a Non-System institution, compared with 76 percent of accepted Non-Pennsylvania applicants.
- Four percent of West Chester accepted applicants did not attend any institution, a slight increase from just under 4 percent in 2016 (Figure 1). A sampled profile⁷ of students who did not attend any institution indicates that more than 28 percent come from families with annual incomes of \$48,000 or below.
- Eighty-one percent of West Chester applicants were from Pennsylvania. The enrollment rate for those applicants was 35 percent.
- The largest group of out-of-state applicants came from New Jersey (13 percent) and Delaware (2 percent). Of those accepted applicants, 18 percent from New Jersey and 19 percent from Delaware enrolled at West Chester.



Who Were the West Chester University Accepted Applicants?⁸

- About 89 percent of West Chester accepted applicants had a high school GPA of 3.0 or above.
- Of the West Chester accepted applicants who had a high school GPA of 3.0 or above and enrolled at an institution of higher education, 31 percent enrolled at West Chester University, 7 percent enrolled at another State System university, and 62 percent enrolled at a Non-System institution.
- Of the West Chester accepted applicants, 74 percent were White, followed by Black (9 percent), Hispanic (8 percent), Two or more races (4 percent), and Asian (3 percent).
- Thirty-two percent of West Chester accepted applicants had a family income of \$75,000 or below. About 17 percent of West Chester accepted applicants had a family income between \$75,000 and \$110,000. Approximately 51 percent had a family income of \$110,000 or above.⁹

Who Were the West Chester University Enrolled Applicants?

- Eighty-four percent of West Chester enrolled applicants had a high school GPA of 3.0 or above.
- Of the West Chester enrolled applicants, 76 percent were White, followed by Black (10 percent), Hispanic (7 percent), Two or more races (4 percent), and Asian (3 percent).
- Thirty-four percent of the West Chester enrolled applicants had a family income of \$75,000 or below. About 19 percent of West Chester enrolled applicants had a family income between \$75,000 and \$110,000. Approximately 47 percent had a family income of \$110,000 or above, as compared with 54 percent of Non-System institution enrolled applicants.

Where Did the Accepted Applicants Go?

- Of the top 20 Non-System competitor universities, 12 are located in Pennsylvania. These 12 universities enrolled 26 percent of the West Chester accepted applicants. Other State System Universities enrolled 7 percent of West Chester accepted applicants.
- Of all West Chester accepted applicants who enrolled at another State System university, 73 percent chose one of the five State System universities within an 86-mile radius of West Chester (Bloomsburg, Millersville, Kutztown, Cheyney, and East Stroudsburg).
- Seventy-eight percent of the Pennsylvania resident West Chester accepted applicants who enrolled at a Non-State System institution chose an institution within Pennsylvania.
- Forty-five percent of the Non-Pennsylvania resident West Chester accepted applicants who enrolled at a Non-State System institution chose an institution within their home state.

Pennsylvania applicants to West Chester stay in PA

78% of PA accepted applicants who chose not to enroll at a State System institution enrolled elsewhere in PA

45% of non-PA accepted applicants who did not enroll at a State System institution ended up enrolling in their home states.

West Chester Accepted Applicants from Pennsylvania who Enrolled at a Non-State System Institution

- West Chester accepted applicants from Pennsylvania who enrolled at a Non-State System institution were mostly White (74 percent), followed by Black (10 percent), Hispanic (8 percent), Asian (5 percent), and Two or more races (3 percent).
- About 21 percent of those Pennsylvania resident accepted applicants had a family income of \$48,000 or below. About 93 percent had a high school GPA of 3.0 or above.
- The top three institutions where those applicants enrolled were Pennsylvania State University, Temple University, and University of Delaware.

West Chester Accepted Applicants from New Jersey who Enrolled at a Non-State System Institution

- West Chester accepted applicants from New Jersey who enrolled at a Non-State System institution were mostly White (84 percent), followed by Hispanic (8 percent), Black (3 percent), Two or more races (3 percent), and Asian (2 percent).
- About 12 percent of those New Jersey resident accepted applicants had a family income of \$48,000 or below. About 91 percent had a high school GPA of 3.0 or above.
- The top three institutions where those applicants enrolled were Rowan University, University of Delaware, and Rutgers University – New Brunswick.

West Chester Accepted Applicants from Delaware who Enrolled at a Non-State System Institution

- West Chester accepted applicants from Delaware who enrolled at a Non-State System institution were mostly White (76 percent), followed by Black (10 percent), Hispanic (8 percent), Two or more races (4 percent), and Asian (2 percent).
- About 17 percent of those Delaware resident accepted applicants had a family income of \$48,000 or below. About 93 percent had a high school GPA of 3.0 or above.
- The top three institutions where those applicants enrolled were University of Delaware, Pennsylvania State University, and Towson University.

West Chester Accepted Applicants from Maryland who Enrolled at a Non-State System Institution

- West Chester accepted applicants from Maryland who enrolled at a Non-State System institution were mostly White (85 percent), followed by Black (8 percent), Two or more races (3 percent), Hispanic (1 percent), and Asian (1 percent).
- About 7 percent of those Maryland resident accepted applicants had a family income of \$48,000 or below. About 96 percent had a high school GPA of 3.0 or above.
- The top three institutions where those applicants enrolled were Towson University, the University of Delaware, and the University of Maryland – College Park.


West Chester Accepted Applicants from New York who Enrolled at a Non-State System Institution

- West Chester accepted applicants from New York who enrolled at a Non-State System institution were mostly White (78 percent), followed by Hispanic (14 percent), Two or more races (4 percent), Black (3 percent), and Asian (1 percent).
- About 9 percent of those New York resident accepted applicants had a family income of \$48,000 or below. About 85 percent had a high school GPA of 3.0 or above.
- The top three institutions where those applicants enrolled were the University of Rhode Island, SUNY New Paltz, and SUNY College – Cortland.



Percent of Accepted Applicants by Enrollment Status




Definitions

1. **Applicants** - First-time in college (FTIC) students who applied to your university to seek a bachelor's degree or an associate degree. Transfer students are not included. Summer applicants who attend in the fall are included.
2. **Accepted applicants** - Students who applied to your university and were accepted by your university.
3. **Accepted students enrolled at your university** - Students who applied to your university, were accepted by your university, and enrolled at your university.
4. **Accepted students enrolled at Non-System institutions** - Students who applied to your university, were accepted by your university, but enrolled at a Non-System Institution.
5. **Accepted students enrolled at another System University** - Students who applied, and were accepted at your university, but enrolled at another System University. If your university's AAE data indicated a student did not enroll at your university and NSC data indicated the student was enrolled at your university, the student was placed in this category.
6. **Not attending** - Students who applied to your university, were accepted by your university, but not enrolled at any institution.
7. **Other race** - A combination of the "American Indian/Alaska Native" and "Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander" race/ethnicity categories.
8. **Top states** - The top states were determined by number of accepted applicants. In the case of ties, secondary ranking was done by number of accepted applicants who enrolled at your university, number of accepted applicants who enrolled at another State System university, and number of accepted applicants who enrolled at a non-System university.
9. **Top high schools** - The top high schools were determined by number of accepted applicants. In the case of ties, secondary ranking was done by number of accepted applicants who enrolled at your university, number of accepted applicants who enrolled at another State System university, and number of accepted applicants who enrolled at a non-System university; if still tied, alphabetical sorting by name was used.

Notes: The sources for this document are university submitted Application, Acceptance and Enrollment Data (AAE) and NSC data. Throughout this document, unknowns were removed from denominators when calculating percentages, and percentages may not add to 100% due to rounding.
